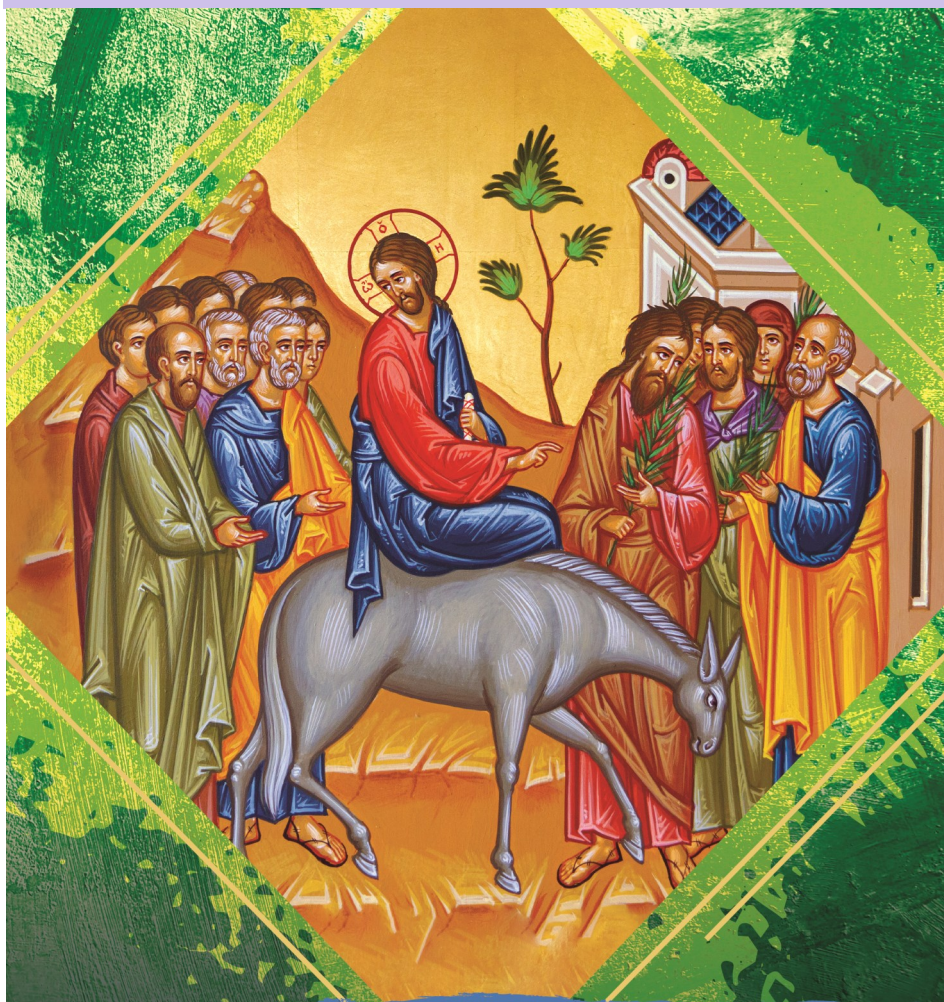

Pastor's Column

Holy Week

As we enter the most sacred time of the year, I want to invite every parishioner to spiritually participate in the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus. There are several ways to participate:

1. **Parish Liturgies:** Special liturgies mark the moments of Christ's passion, death and resurrection. On Holy Thursday we recall the Last Supper with a special 7:00 p.m. Mass. On Good Friday the crucifixion is commemorated by the Celebration of the Passion at 7:00 p.m. On Holy Saturday, the celebration of Christ's resurrection begins at 8:00 p.m. with the Easter Vigil. Our Easter Masses celebrating the resurrection of Jesus will be at 7:30 a.m., 9:00 a.m., 10:30 a.m. and Noon.
2. **Devotions:** On Holy Thursday, Christ's agony in the Garden is commemorated by the silent prayer at the altar of repose from 8:00 p.m.-Midnight. On Good Friday we observe the three hours (Tre Ore) that Jesus hung on the Cross beginning at Noon with Stations of the Cross followed by meditations on the "Seven Last Words of Christ" until 3:00 p.m. when we pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.
3. **Fasting:** Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence. All Catholics ages 14 and up are required to abstain from meat. All Catholics ages 18-59 are also required to fast. Fasting means to reduce one's food intake to only one full meal and two smaller meals with no snacks in-between. However, liquids are permitted. The spirit of fasting is to mortify the flesh for past sins and control our appetites so we may overcome future temptations.
4. **Confession:** Since Jesus died to reconcile us to the Father, making a good confession is very appropriate. The Sacrament of Penance is available on Wednesday from 6:00-7:00 p.m., on Good Friday from Noon-3:00 p.m., and on Holy Saturday from 4:00-5:00 p.m.
5. **Personal Prayer:** If we cannot participate in the liturgies or devotions, it is important to take time, especially on Good Friday, to contemplate the love of Jesus. Reading one of the accounts of the crucifixion from the evangelists is a powerful way to enter into silent prayer of thanksgiving. Praying the Sorrowful Mysteries of the Rosary is another appropriate way to pray during Holy Week.

All these spiritual practices help prepare us for a worthy celebration of Easter where we joyfully proclaim that death is not the end of human life. The reception of Holy Communion on Easter is the high point of the spiritual life where we welcome our bridegroom into our body and soul.

Be aware of changes to our normal schedule. According to ancient customs, there will be no morning Masses on Holy Thursday, Good Friday, or Holy Saturday. There will be no Saturday 5:00 p.m. Mass. And because Easter Sunday afternoon is family time, there will not be a Sunday 6:00 p.m. Mass either. The Adoration Chapel will be closed from Holy Thursday at 6:30 p.m. to Holy Saturday at 10:30 p.m. Also, because our parishioners from Myanmar, Asia, celebrate Mass here on Sunday afternoons we will not have a Divine Mercy Sunday service or confessions on April 7.

I hope everyone has a blessed Holy Week and a joy filled Easter.

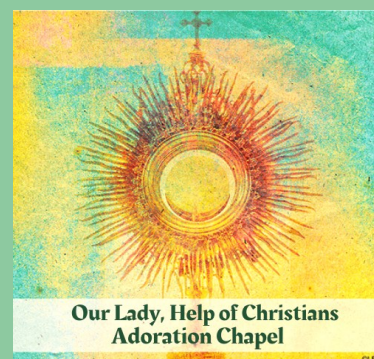

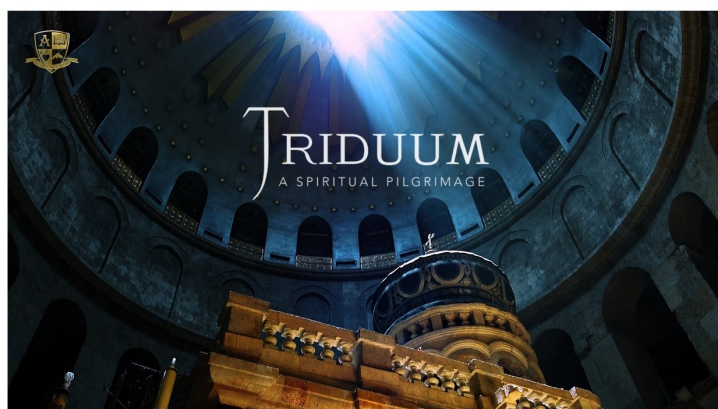
