

VOCATION NEWS

Kenrick Seminarian, Mark Koenemann has been helping on Sunday mornings. Mark is completing his second year of theology at Kenrick. Mark serves Mass on Sundays, helps distribute Holy Communion, and occasionally reads at Mass. In the past, we usually were assigned first year seminarians who were also expected to help with youth ministry. However, Mark is in his second year, so we were expected to introduce Mark to the sick and elderly at Assumption. So Mark has helped with the Communion Services at Delmar Gardens South, rode along with the Assumption Shuttle, took Holy Communion to the homebound and visited with our seniors at coffee and doughnuts. Unfortunately, Mark is completing his time here next Sunday, April 28. Mark has been a great asset to our parish, and we hope he comes back to visit! Mark's summer assignment will be at St. Charles Borromeo parish in St. Charles. Please pray for Mark as he continues his studies at Kenrick Glennon Seminary.

Permanent Deacon candidate Jeremy Remiger is nearing his ordination at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 8 at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis. Everyone is invited to the ordination. Jeremy, his wife April and children Aiden and Nora are Assumption parishioners. Jeremy is on faculty at Vianney High School and has worked in Youth Ministry. The permanent deacon formation program is six years and includes nighttime and Saturday classes. Jeremy has performed various functions at the altar appropriate to his level of formation. Soon, Jeremy will be joining Deacon Dave and Deacon Mike in proclaiming the Gospel, preaching, and performing the sacraments of Baptism and Holy Matrimony. We do not know if Jeremy will be assigned to Assumption parish yet, but we hope he will be assigned here. Regardless, Jeremy's ordination will be a special time for Assumption to celebrate God's work among our parish. It is a great privilege for us to have vocations to Holy Orders from our parish. Everyone is invited to a special Mass of Thanksgiving on Sunday, June 9 at Noon followed by a reception.

Seminarian Gaten Armstrong from St. Meinrad Seminary in Indiana will be living at the Assumption Rectory for the months of June and July. Gaten is a seminarian for the diocese of Mobile, Alabama. He will be participating in a summer chaplaincy program at Mercy South. When Gaten arrives, please make an extra effort to welcome him because, unlike our other seminarians who have stayed with us, he will not have family or friends in the St. Louis area. We want this to be a special and positive time of discernment for Gaten. I know Assumption parishioners will make him feel at home.

Assumption-Mattese has been blessed with homegrown vocations to the priesthood, diaconate, and religious life over the past 185 years. We have also been honored to participate in the spiritual, pastoral, and liturgical formation of many more seminarians. It is the responsibility of every priest to be an inspiration to young people and to encourage them to open their hearts to God's will. But it is also the responsibility of parishioners to pray for vocations to Holy Orders and religious life. We should implore God to "send laborers into the harvest." It is also the responsibility of every parent (and grandparent) to encourage their children to consider priesthood or religious life. Just as a healthy parish produces vocations, a healthy family inspires vocations too.






LIVING WITH LOSS: Widow/Widower Support Group

Process To Withdraw Your Signature From the Abortion Initiative

Create a Sworn Statement: Draft a written statement that includes the following information: The name you used when signing the petition. Your address. Your county of residence.

Swear Under Oath; The statement must be sworn under oath. You can do this by visiting a notary public. Submit to the Secretary of State: Send the sworn statement to the Missouri Secretary of State. You can mail it or deliver it in person. Include your contact information so they can verify your identity. Send / Deliver to:


