

Pastor's Column

Fr. Thomas Keller

Everyone loves a good trivia game. Here's some Assumption trivia:

Assumption began as a mission of Notre Dame de Mount Carmel Parish (later known as Ss. Mary and Joseph Parish in South St. Louis.) What year was Assumption founded?

Answer: 1839.

Fr. Edmond Saulnier and Fr. Joseph Fischer started two missions at the same time, one was Assumption. What was the other one called?

Answer: Immaculate Conception in Arnold.

Assumption's original boundaries were south of the River de Peres, west of the Mississippi River, north of the Meramec River and east of Gravois Road. What parishes were eventually carved out of Assumption's original boundaries?

Answer: St. Andrew's, St. Paul's in Fenton, St. George, Immaculate Heart of Mary, Seven Holy Founders, St. Francis of Assisi, St. Catherine Laboure, St. Simon's, St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Mark's (formerly St. Matthias, St. Bernadette, Mary Queen of the Universe, Most Precious Blood, St. Timothy, St Martin of Tours,) Queen of All Saints, and Mary Mother of the Church.

When Assumption was founded, how many Catholic families lived in the parish boundaries? *Answer: Seven.*

What is the oldest continuously operating parish grade school in the archdiocese of St. Louis? *Answer: Assumption Grade School, founded 1848.*

Assumption's first resident pastor became the bishop of Green Bay, Wisconsin. What was his name? *Answer: Bishop Joseph Melcher, pastor from 1842-1847*.

What religious community of nuns taught at Assumption school from 1922 until 1973. Answer: Precious Blood Sisters from O'Fallon, Missouri.

Fr. Schlattmann's hobby was breeding pigeons. He was the first to import Birmingham Roller Pigeons to the United States. Today, what percentage of Birmingham Roller Pigeons in the United States are direct descendants of his original imported pigeons?

Answer: about 100%

Which Assumption pastor was killed in an automobile accident on his way to deposit the Sunday collection in the bank? (The collection was never recovered.)

Answer: Fr. Fredrick Schlattmann, pastor from 1920-1947.

In 1942, St. Louis City and County passed a \$4.5 million bond issues to build something, and the original plan was to buy Assumption and the neighboring farms. What were they going to move here?

Answer: The airport!


Ordained Servants of Word, Sacrament and Service




