Pastor's Column

What was life like at Assumption 100 years ago? The parish had a publication called the "Assumption Parish Messenger." This is what Pastor, Fr. Schlattmann, had to say in 1924:

"The Assumption Church and school are supported by the people at four terms or quarters a year. The Assumption Church has no rental of pews – all pews are free. Neither does the parish ask school money from children – the school is free."

"Since a complete education is so utterly necessary for our boys and girls, if they are to succeed in life, we again must remind our parents of their strict duty to please let their children finish the eighth grade."

"At the hour [of death] the length of the Masses you have heard will be your greatest consolation."

"Some time toward the end of February work will begin on a cistern for Sisters. This will be a quite a big undertaking, but a large number of men can complete the job in quick order. We hope the men of the parish will not disappoint the Sisters who are doing so much for the children."

"The part of Oakville which surrounds the Retreat House is called "the Point" on account of the angle formed by the Mississippi and Meramec Rivers. According to the Census Records of Assumption, taken up last November, there are 19 Catholic families, numbering 82 souls, living down there... the Jesuit Fathers have extended them (the privilege) permitting them to attend holy Mass at the Retreat House."

"One often hears it said in derogation of a priest "that he is always begging." Instead of being a reproach against the priest, this is a reproach of the people for being stingy."

"The editor of the Assumption Parish Messenger suggests that all our families cultivate a little garden for the purpose of providing flowers for the church."

"We must stir up somehow in the Catholic mothers and fathers of America a greater desire, not to say willingness, to see their sons and daughters become priests and sisters. It is the glory of Catholic families in Europe, notably Ireland and certain parts of France, that each household is eager to see at least one of its members ascend the altar of God or become consecrated to His service in religious life... How the world would be filled with yet a greater number of fervent priests and devoted religious men and women if our Catholic parents would pray more and desire more to see their children consecrated to God."

"Our ladies have indeed been very busy at the meetings of the Sewing Circle during the winter months and have made many beautiful quilts and other useful articles to be disposed of at our festivals and euchres for the benefit of the parish. It is too bad, however, that that in the past so many of our ladies have failed to show an interest in the Sewing Circle and did not join as members."

"Our patron feast, the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary in heaven will be celebrated with a Solemn High Mass at eight o'clock, Friday August 15. A strange priest will be present to give the sermon."




May 20th, we welcome the International NTERNATIONAL Institute for the next Senior Speaker Series. The International


