

Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

Assumption Parish has the opportunity to collaborate with an organization called Communio. Communio helps churches evangelize through fostering relationships and promoting renewal in marriage and family life. The name Communio is Latin for "association, fellowship, communion" and they strive to strengthen church communities.

Communio has a very different starting point for ministry - and this is what makes them effective: they analyze demographic, biographical, and consumer data in the area to develop specific marketing strategies and then they track results. They use data to identify what kind of programming is most needed in an area and how to more effectively invite people to participate. Communio's primary concern is to improve Christian marriage and family life. They identify singles, engaged couples, married couples, and families and then they help parishes provide meaningful programing and content specifically for those groups. By focusing on these groups, it benefits all age groups and revitalizes the parish.

If we entered into a partnership with Communio, a parish leadership team from Assumption would work with a consultant to create different kinds of events to attract Catholics in the area. Some events are fun and social in nature, some events are intended to foster relationships, and some events include Catholic content that strengthens marriage, family life, and personal faith.

Communio studied the churches they partner with, and they have found improved attendance on Sunday and increased participation in parish life. I think specifically of how our ACTS retreat recruitment would benefit. Or, how we could tailor our ministries to serve the needs of the area better. Communio also observes that the counties where multiple churches participate see a decrease in divorces and a reduction in overall poverty rates. We could include our neighbors at St. Martha's to better address domestic needs in the area.

This effect on poverty has caught the attention of Catholic Charities and they have grant money available for parishes to use to begin working with Communio. They identified several parishes including Assumption as locations to begin introducing Communio to the archdiocese. The grant would help us afford Communio's resources. However, the grant would not cover all the expenses. Hopefully there will be parishioners who believe in the program and would help us fund it. If we decide to participate, we would be making a three-year commitment to the partnership.

I think the time may be right for Assumption to benefit from Communio's experience. A lot of young couples and new families are moving into the parish but many have lost touch with their faith. Our AELC and Grade School also attracts families who may not yet be as connected to parish life. We are registering Catholics from around the area who are looking for a permanent parish following "All Things New" moves. Maybe Communio can build a bridge between these families and Assumption parish life.

If you want to do some research for yourself, go to <u>communio.org</u>. I'm looking for feedback from you. Does this idea excite you? Do you think we can put together an effective leadership team? Will existing parish organizations rally around a new way of reaching out to people? What do you think? Everyone is invited to a presentation by Communio representatives on Wednesday, July 10 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. in the Church Lower Level to discuss if this program is right for Assumption.

- Candidates should be familiar with middle school literature and able to teach a variety of writing styles and the process of writing a research paper.








