Pastor's Column

When Pope Leo XIII finished celebrating Mass, as he knelt down to say prayers, suddenly he saw a vision from the Book of Revelations 12:7-9 where it says, "there was a great battle in heaven; Michael and his angels fought with the dragon, the ancient serpent who is called the devil and Satan, who seduces the whole world...was cast unto the earth, and his angels [the demons] were thrown down with him." Some say that the pope fainted at the end of the vision. Later that day, the pope was so horrified by the vision that he took a pen and paper and wrote down a prayer:

Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray; and do Thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the Divine Power of God,

cast into hell Satan and all the evil spirits who roam throughout the world seeking the ruin of souls.

The year was 1886 and Pope Leo XIII ordered that the prayer be copied and said by Catholics everywhere. Leo believed we were entering into a period of history where Satan and the Fallen Angels would be more active, and the influence of the Church in the world would dramatically decrease. However, today many Christians no longer consider Satan a threat. Many people do not think the devil is real. But St. Peter wrote, "be sober and alert, because your adversary the devil as a roaring lion, goes about seeking whom he may devour." (1 Peter 5:8).

The fallen angels are clever but predictable, they rarely possess someone physically, but they are always at war for the control of the mind. This is how evil spirits destroy souls:

- 1. Imagination: They suggest sinful images to your mind leading to lust and greed.
- 2. Memory: They pull memories of past sins or incite anger due to past injuries.
- 3. Emotions: They intensify emotions to the point that we are no longer in control. One of their favorites is to foster discouragement.
- 4. Reasoning: They introduce lies to us, so that our thoughts are fallible, and conclusions are incorrect.
- 5. Distraction: They guide us toward the traps of pleasure, so we neglect spiritual things.
- 6. Perceptions: They distort our perceptions of others so that we think poorly of them leading to divisions, resentments, and envy.

Sometimes our battle to return control of the mind is called "Spiritual Warfare." The Church uses proven tactics to conquer the attacks of evil spirits:

- 1. Frequent Confession: Satan is confounded by humility since he knows only pride.
- 2. Examination of Conscience: You can ask yourself, "where is Satan at work in my mind?"
- 3. Reveal temptations to a confessor or spiritual mentor: acknowledging our weaknesses avoids isolation where it is easier to sin.
- 4. Fight back: Call on the intercession of the Blessed Mother, St. Michael, your guardian angel, and the saints.
- 5. Conform you mind to Christ: Reflect on the truth of Sacred Scripture, sound teachings of the Church, and the authentic spiritual life as described by the saints.
