Feast of the Assumption

August 15th is the solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. It is our parish feast day! It is also a Holy Day of Obligation. All Catholics must attend Holy Mass that day unless somehow encumbered by serious obligation of work or limited by illness. Our special Mass schedule is 6:30 a.m., 8:00 a.m., Noon, 5:30 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. We will celebrate with our annual "Feast on the Feast Day" food trucks from 6:00 p.m. - 8:30 p.m.

School Staffing Update

As this school year begins, we are welcoming several new staff members: Katie Koberlein, K-8 principal, Michele Emmons, school nurse, Kathleen Koenigsfeld, art teacher, Ashlee Glass, 1st grade teacher, and Kathleen Mitchell, middle school math aide. Welcome to Assumption!

Eucharistic Adoration

For the past 30 years, Assumption has been blessed to have perpetual adoration. Ideally, we would like to have 2 adorers per hour. We need 12 adorers to fill empty times and another 66 adorers to have 2 per hour throughout the week. There are cards in the pews to sign-up and a schedule in the back of church to identify open times. If you commit to one hour of prayer a week, we will be able to continue the beautiful tradition of uninterrupted prayer here at Assumption.

New Campus Public Address System

Eagle-eyed parishioners will notice new white speakers on the exterior of some of our buildings. It is part of a much larger new P.A. system. The interior speakers in the school will be used for routine announcements, however, in case of an emergency, the exterior speakers can notify everyone on campus of an emergency. Last year's auction made the new P.A. possible. Thanks to everyone who volunteered, donated, or participated in the auction. This is a much-needed upgrade to the campus.

HVAC Update

I've mentioned in recent months that we need to begin replacing nearly all the HVAC units on the campus. Monsignor Dempsey installed new air conditioning at the school and built the Parish Center in 1996. Those units have served us well, but they are at the end of their life expectancy. We also need a new boiler in the Salesian House (former convent) and the AC in the church continues to struggle at times to cool and remove humidity from the building. Generous volunteers from our maintenance committee have helped us keep the systems going, but it is time to switch to reliable energy efficient units. Last week, we began the process by replacing one rooftop unit on the three-story section of the school. The total cost was \$52,651 but this is only the beginning...

Queen of Hearts

Did you know our Queen of Hearts game is still going? Your odds get better each week as a new card is drawn and there are fewer cards to be selected. But you have to buy a chance each week if you want to win! The winner splits the jackpot with the parish 50/50. If the Queen of Hearts is drawn, you might win!
