## Pastor's Column

I'm quite amazed at the response to our requests for new Eucharistic Adorers. Back in spring we made an appeal for new adorers around the feast of Corpus Christi, and throughout August while the Bread of Life Discourse was being read at Mass during the Gospel. Since then we have received a surprising 84 new adorers including 12 hours that were not attended at all. We still need to fill 7 open hours (mostly at night) and 52 open places so that we have two adorers at all times.

A Holy Hour is a beautiful time for deep, personal prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament. Whether you are an adorer or not, here's a method that can guide you through an hour of prayer:

### 1. Opening Prayer (5-10 minutes)

**Adoration:** Begin with an act of adoration, acknowledging the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. You might say something like, "My Lord and my God, I believe that you are truly present here."

**Invocation of the Holy Spirit:** Ask the Holy Spirit to guide your prayer, opening your heart to God's will.

### 2. Scripture Reading and Meditation (15-20 minutes)

**Choose a Passage:** Select a passage from the Gospels or Psalms that speaks to your heart.

**Spiritual Reading:** Read the passage slowly, perhaps multiple times, allowing a word or phrase to resonate with you. Meditate on its meaning and how God might be speaking to you through it.

### 3. Conversation with Jesus (10-15 minutes)

**Personal Dialogue:** Speak to Jesus as you would to a friend, sharing your thoughts, concerns, joys, and struggles. Listen for His response in the silence of your heart.

**Intercessory Prayer:** Pray for others—family, friends, the Church, and the world.

### 4. Silence and Meditative Prayer (10-15 minutes)

**Contemplative prayer:** Spend time in silent adoration, simply being in the presence of Jesus. Let go of words and thoughts, resting in His love. If you feel called, enter into contemplative prayer, focusing on the presence of God. Pour out your love for Him.

### 5. Closing Prayer (5-10 minutes)

**Thanksgiving:** Thank Jesus for the time spent together and for any insights or consolations you received.

**Resolution:** Make a resolution to carry the grace of this hour into your daily life.

### Optional: Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet

If you have left over time, you might consider praying the Rosary or Divine Mercy Chaplet, offering it for specific intentions.

This method combines different forms of prayer—adoration, meditation, conversation, and contemplation—helping you make the most of your time in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament.

Now more than ever, there are constant challenges to God's gift of human life in our culture. In this major election year, we are frequently seeing this issue in political advertising. In addition, it was recently announced that Amendment 3 will be on the Missouri ballot in November. If passed, this amendment will remove many restrictions to abortion access and codify this access in the Missouri constitution. It is important that we Catholics become more aware and supportive of pro-life ministries both within our parish and in our region. There are many pro-life organizations providing critical services to people experiencing unexpected pregnancies. The need for these services is already apparent and will be even more critical if abortion is re-established in Missouri.
