

#### Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

#### **Constitutional Amendment**

Unfortunately, in November voters will see the "Missouri Constitutional Amendment 3, Right to Reproductive Freedom Initiative" on the ballots. Because this amendment would directly enshrine abortion in the Missouri Constitution, no Christian can support it or any other measure like it, nor can we support any candidate that encourages similar measures on the local, state, or federal level without personally breaking the commandment "thou shall not kill." While one might say we are not actively promoting, encouraging, or participating directly in the act of murder, to permit abortion by voting for it in any way is still sufficient to sin gravely. To calculate prior to voting that one can simply confess the sin in the Sacrament of Reconciliation is to commit the sin of presumption, which may invalidate the confession itself due to a real lack of contrition. Life and death are serious things, especially when it includes innocent human life. Propaganda before elections can hide and distort the truth and they are produced to manipulate our feelings, however exercising our civic duty is a great responsibility and it is imperative that Catholics look beyond rhetoric and emotions to understand the issues and each candidate's positions before we vote, especially when lives are at stake. It is important to remember that no other institution on earth has ever worked harder to provide support and care for women with an unplanned pregnancy than the Catholic Church, so we can and should do everything we can to support both parent and child.

#### Communio Update

Everything seems to have come together, and it looks like Assumption Parish will be partnering with Communio. You may remember we had a parish town hall in the Spring to discuss the possibility of a partnership. Communio equips churches to evangelize through healthy relationships, marriage and family life. Anyone who has seen our 9:00 and 10:30 Masses knows we have a lot of young families. But we hope that this is just the beginning of a rebirth of faith in our neighborhood. Communio "helps church leadership team select, promote, and run large, attractional community outreach events that flow people into ongoing engagement, and ultimately into relationship-based ministry." As pastor, I am hoping that Communio does the same thing that ACTS has done for the parish, but for a younger generation.

#### More Seminarians Coming

Each year, Kenrick-Glennon sends seminarians to parishes to assist at Sunday Mass and serve in another parish ministry. This year, we are hosting three seminarians. Joining us for the first semester will be Dr. Jean Marie Hogan, O.S.B. and Br. Angelus Atkinson, O.S.B. They are solemnly professed Benedictine monks from St. Benedict's Abbey in Atchison, Kansas. Their monastery is associated with Benedictine College, but the monks also assist in parishes in their area. They are attending Kenrick Seminary for their priestly formation. Br. Jean Marie and Br. Angelus will assist with Assumption Youth Ministry. The third seminarian is Jacob Knott. Jacob is a second-year student from the diocese of Kansas City-St. Joseph, Missouri. Jacob will work with the sick and elderly in the parish for the entire academic year. In addition to helping at Sunday Mass, Jacob will rotate between the Sunday Communion Service at Delmar Gardens South and the Assumption Shuttle that transports elderly to the 10:30 a.m. Mass. He will also take Holy Communion to a few of our homebound parishioners. Please give a warm welcome to Br. Angelus, Br. Jean Marie, and Jacob. They are assigned here to get to know you!



There are many pro-life organizations providing critical services to people experiencing unexpected pregnancies. The need for these services is already apparent and will be even more critical if abortion is re-established in Missouri.






