

# Pastor's Column

### Do you know someone who would like to be Catholic?

Assumption is a vibrant and active community, we are blessed to share our faith through so many ministries, celebrations, and acts of service. Yet, there is one invitation we may not always have on our minds: the call to invite others into the fullness of our Catholic faith.

Is there someone you know who might be seeking more in their spiritual life? Perhaps a family member friend, neighbor, or co-worker who:

- Has never been baptized but is searching for meaning and belonging?
- Was baptized in another Christian tradition but is interested in learning more about becoming Catholic?
- Was baptized Catholic but has drifted away from the faith and is looking for a way back?
- Regularly practices the faith but for some reason has not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation?

The Order of Christian Initiation for Adults (OCIA) is a journey of conversion, learning, and spiritual growth for all those seeking to enter into full communion with the Church. This is not only an opportunity for those who wish to become Catholic but also for those already Catholic who are seeking to complete their initiation through the Sacrament of Confirmation

I encourage you to pray and reflect on who in your life might be open to this invitation. Sometimes, all it takes is a personal word of encouragement to help someone begin their journey of faith.

If you know someone who might be interested or if you yourself are feeling called to deepen your relationship with Christ and His Church, we invite you to reach out to our parish office to learn more about the OCIA process. All inquiries are welcome, and there is no pressure or commitment.

Deacon Michael Thompson accompanies individuals through the process of inquiry about the Catholic Faith, deepening commitment to Christ, and preparation for the sacraments. If you know someone, invite them to contact Deacon Michael and begin the journey. Classes begin in October and often candidates are ready to receive the sacraments by Easter. 




