

#### Pastor's Column Fr. Thomas Keller

#### Veneration of the Relics of St. Jude

The relics of St. Jude the Apostle are coming to Assumption on November 9, 2024, from 1:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. St. Jude is one of the Twelve Apostles. St. Jude is sometimes called Thaddeus in the Gospels. He may have been a relative of Jesus. There is a New Testament epistle attributed to St. Jude that urges Christians to hold fast to the faith. Tradition holds that St. Jude died along with St. Simon the Zealot around 65AD. St. Jude's feast day is October 28.

Devotion to St. Jude has developed over the centuries to include the title "Patron of Impossible Causes." Catholics often turn to St. Jude's intercession for help with particularly hopeless, dire, and difficult situations. Images of St. Jude sometimes show him holding an image of Jesus and sometimes St. Jude is shown holding an axe (symbol of his martyrdom). Devotion to St. Jude is still very much alive, we have a statue of St. Jude in our church near the cry room entrance, and many people stop to say a prayer there every day. Fr. Carlos Martins has been entrusted with a relic of the "arm of St. Jude" and he has been charged by the diocese of Rome to display the relics for the veneration of the faithful in various cities. The tour is intended to foster devotion to St. Jude and to raise funds to repair the shrine of St. Jude in Rome.

The relics will be on display in Assumption church starting with a special 1:00 p.m. Mass, preached by Fr. Carlos Martins; then everyone is welcome to come forward to personally pray before the relics after Mass. We will pause veneration for our normal 5:00 p.m. Mass. Then veneration will continue after Mass until 9:00 p.m. The pope grants a plenary indulgence under the usual conditions (confession, communion, detachment from sin) to all who venerate the relics of St. Jude that day.

I am always happy to say yes to events like this. Assumption is a great location for archdiocesan events, we have great parish volunteers, our campus and facilities are easy for people to access, and we get a front-row seat for interesting things. I hope everyone comes.

#### Devotion to the Holy Face of Jesus.

A generous donor gave us copies of "The Secret of the Holy Face," by Fr. Lawrence Daniel Carney III. In case you are not familiar with the devotion to the Holy Face, I became acquainted with the devotion when I was in the seminary when I picked up an antique print of a woodcut off the "free table" where seminarians could toss stuff they didn't want anymore. The image was curious to me, so I took it. Later I realized it was an 19th Century artist's depiction of the Veil of St. Veronica when the relic was on display to the public in St. Peter's in Rome. If you are familiar with the Stations of the Cross, a woman called Veronica reached out to Jesus while He was carrying the cross to wipe the sweat and blood off His Holy Face. The image of Jesus remained on the veil. There are a few details in scripture that might refer to this veil like the reference to a veil left behind after Jesus' resurrection and a veil that St. Paul mentions, but mostly it is a tradition that comes down to us from the Middle Ages. On a deeper level, the Old Testament often returns to a theme where our souls were created to see the face of God and that we will not be at true peace until we look on the face of God. The devotion to the Holy Face of Jesus is built on this innate desire. Fr. Carney's book explores this devotion and tries to give a modern interpretation by pointing out how devotion to the Holy Face is a remedy for the world's godlessness, especially as we approach another election. Please take a book and use it for your spiritual reading or pass it on to someone who might appreciate it.

#### Help The Holy Land

On the weekend of Nov 2nd and 3rd Mary & Khader Abu Sada a Catholic couple from the Holy Land will be visiting our parish to market olive wood hand carved religious articles made by the Christian artisans in the Holy Land. With the hostilities worsening in the Holy Land and due to the lack of Christian pilgrims, the outlets for the olive wood hand carvings have been closed, leading unemployment to increase up to 75%, forcing many Christians to leave the Holy Land in order to find other ways to market their handiwork. But, the absence of a living Christian community is very disastrous for the Holy sites, such as the Church of Nativity and the Church of the Holy Sepulcher.

This sale is to strengthen the Christian presence in the city of Bethlehem the birthplace of Jesus and the surrounding areas. All proceeds will go directly to the Christian families and the artisans who are working in this type of hand carvings. They are going to display all kinds of olive wood religious art works such as: Nativity scenes, Crucifixes, figures, rosaries, etc. which are unique and not usually found in religious stores. These crafts make wonderful presents for all occasions especially for Christmas. Checks and credit card are welcome.

Please take the opportunity on Nov 2nd & 3rd to check out these unique crafts and hopefully you would be able to assist our brothers and sisters in the Land of Jesus by purchasing some of these religious goods. Buying one piece will help prevent Christians from leaving the Holy Land.


