The Visit of St. Jude - November 9

The relics of St. Jude are usually housed in a church in Rome that is currently under restoration. The relics are bones from St. Jude's arm, and they are in an arm-shaped reliquary raised in blessing. They will be here at Assumption on November 9 starting with a special Mass celebrated by Fr. Carlos Martins at 1:00 p.m. The relics have been entrusted to Fr Martins while the church is being restored to promote devotion. Then the relics will be available for public veneration from after Mass until 9:00 p.m. However, we will interrupt veneration for the normal 5:00 p.m. Mass.

St. Jude the Apostle is known as the patron saint of impossible cases. Many people turn to the intercession of St. Jude for seemingly hopeless causes. His statue here at Assumption is often a place of prayer for parishioners before and after Mass. I am sure everyone knows someone who is dealing with a difficult situation, join us in prayer to ask St. Jude to intercede for your intention.

Thanksgiving Family Brunch

Recently Assumption has been hosting a Thanksgiving Brunch after the special 9:00 a.m. Thanksgiving Mass. The parish provides breakfast casseroles and traditional Thanksgiving turkey fare. Parishioners are encouraged to bring sides and desserts. All parishioners are invited. Parishioners are also encouraged to invite anyone who might be alone for Thanksgiving to join us.

Communio Surveys

Thanks to everyone who filled out the recent Communio Survey. So far, 669 individuals completed the survey. The information will help Communio tailor our future relationship ministry opportunities.

The James II Project Update

Assumption volunteers are feeding the hungry through the James 2 Project lunches on the fourth Thursday of the month at the Salvation Army facility on South Telegraph. Volunteers prepare and serve lunch to the homeless. The time commitment includes training and background checks, then you help on Thursdays (or another day if you prefer) from 9:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. If you want to volunteer, just email me at kellert@assumptionstl.org. Also, the James 2 Project organizers are looking for volunteers with Case Worker experience to help during the week. Case Workers identify needs and refer to appropriate services. If you have experience with this service and would like to help, let me know.

Kairos Retreats for Prisoners

Some men of Assumption are getting involved in Kairos Retreats at the state correctional centers in Potosi and Bonne Terre, Missouri. The Greek word, "Kairos" refers to "God's time" and the retreats are aimed at providing participants an opportunity to deepen personal conversion and commitment to Christ. Retreats are held in the prison chapel/activity center with the inmates. Maybe God is inviting some of our men to participate in an upcoming retreat. If one of our parishioners invites you to participate, please give it prayerful consideration. I've been offering Holy Mass once a month for Catholic inmates at the Potosi Correctional Center. It is a little intimidating to enter the prison and to be around the general population of prisoners at first, but then you realize that the prisoners who attend Mass are men who really want to reform their lives, it is great joy to be with them.
