FIAT SERVICE LOG

Each candidate for Confirmation is asked to complete 7 *Faith in Action Tasks*, or FIAT for short. There is no requirement of length of time served, but an appropriate task should take at least 30 minutes to one hour. The Confirmation coordinator will regularly share opportunities for service in our parish and community. Making a gift of oneself to the parish or community is a sign of Christian witness and aspect of mature Christian life.

Candidates will complete a total of 7 FIAT tasks in the following categories.

- **PRAYER AND LITURGY (COMPLETE 2)**
 - Attend a daily Mass outside of school or PSR schedule
 - *** You should always attend Sunday Mass and Mass on holy days of obligation, so these do not count as an “extra” Mass
 - Make a 30 minute visit to the Adoration chapel. Code is provided by the parish office.
 - Attend the Parish Holy Hour (Wednesdays, 6-7 PM)
 - Pray a novena for 9 days in a row
 - Read a Gospel in its entirety
 - Be an altar server on Sundays for the year – and serve your scheduled days
- **EVANGELIZATION AND PARISH LIFE (COMPLETE 2)**
 - Volunteer at a Fish Fry, Thanksgiving brunch, or other parish event/retreat
 - Assist Ms. Stringer with Sacramental Prep class nights or retreats on Oct. 22, 23, Nov. 16, March 25, 26, April 8, 9, or April 26.
 - Attend 2 EDGE nights for 1 FIAT; EDGE meets 2 times per month on Wednesdays, 5:30-7 PM. See bulletin for schedule or contact Dani Meyer for all the info (meyerd@assumptionstl.org)
- **CORPORAL WORKS OF MERCY / SERVICE TO THE POOR (COMPLETE 3)**
 - Work with our St. Vincent de Paul society to organize the pantry, pack food for distribution
 - Volunteer at Birthright, Our Lady’s Inn or Pregnancy Resource Centers
 - Volunteer at a hospital or nursing home, organize a group visit to the residents
 - Serve at a homeless shelter, soup kitchen or ministry to the homeless
 - Organize a collection of items (food, clothing or household) given to the needy

**** You may add scheduled, but not yet completed tasks to your service log. For example, there will be Fish Fries happening in April, but the service log is due March 31. Write the date you INTEND to complete the service in your log and then do the service task as planned.*
