Confirmation Prep Schedule (7th/8th Grade)

The sacrament of Confirmation completes Christian initiation into the Catholic Church, which was begun at Baptism. The gifts of the Holy Spirit are made accessible, and the soul is empowered to be a witness for Christ in the world.



Those who receive the Sacrament of Confirmation will prepare spiritually and academically for at least 6 months prior to reception of the Sacrament. Academic preparation for the Sacraments will mostly be conducted during classes in the School or PSR, with the exception of the following events.
