

Assumption Early Learning Center Toilet Training Agreement

In order to make toilet training a positive experience for you and your child, we have written a plan to assist in achieving this goal. This agreement is for the parent and the classroom teacher to follow. Parents and classroom teachers must agree on when to start the process of toilet training and will both put forth effort in order to make the child successful at their own pace.

At any time during the toilet training process, AELC reserves the right to stop the process and begin at a later agreed upon date. All children, no matter their age, will be assisted in the process by the staff of AELC.

Toilet Training Agreement includes:

- Parents will supply appropriate clothing. Diapers, onesies (under legs snap shirts), tights, overalls, belts and other clothing which may make it difficult for the child to begin the self-reliance aspect of toilet training are not to be worn. We recommend elastic waist pants, shorts or dresses and pull-ups or toilet training underwear.
- Additional clothing must be available in case children soil themselves. We recommend 3-4 changes of clothing including underwear and socks.
- AELC will provide pull-ups. Parents will provide training underwear.
- Parents are responsible to communicate with the classroom teacher regarding any supplies.
- Physical punishment or threats will never be used as a means of toilet accidents or toilet training
- If a child has three accidents in one day, they will be put in pull-ups for the remainder of the day.

Agreement: (original to be kept in child's file, copy to parent and teacher). We the parents and the classroom teacher will make every effort towards the goal of toilet training. I understand that it is a shared process and takes every effort from the classroom teacher during school hours and the parents during non-school hours. We will keep in daily communication on the progress of the toilet training process.
