



Tuition Assistance

Alive! In Christ Scholarship (Archdiocesan)

The “Alive! in Christ” Scholarship Program seeks to provide financial assistance to those families (both Catholic and Non-Catholic) who wish to offer their children an education at a Catholic elementary school in the archdiocese. Scholarship awards are based upon the financial need of the applicant and will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. Applications of all income-eligible families with students attending eligible schools will be considered, regardless of faith.

Where do I apply? The application can be found at www.ttef-stl.org.

When can I apply? January 21 – February 28 – The awards are first-come, first-served.

How do I qualify? Scholarships are awarded based on financial need.

Beyond Sunday Scholarship (Archdiocesan)

The Beyond Sunday Education Fund Scholarship Program provides tuition assistance to middle-income families seeking a Catholic education for their children. Awards are available to students attending most Catholic elementary and high schools in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Beyond Sunday is open to students of all faiths, with preference given to Catholic students. Elementary school awards renew through the eighth grade, and high school awards renew through the twelfth grade. Annual income requalification is required for all awards.

When can I apply? January 21 – February 28

How do I qualify? Scholarships are awarded based on financial need and are limited to one per family per school although families may be eligible for additional tuition assistance through other programs.

Catholic Family Tuition Assistance (Archdiocesan)

Grants are made on the basis of financial need as determined by the application process. Grants may be used for Catholic children to attend an archdiocesan or parochial elementary school or an archdiocesan or parochial high school.

When can I apply? January 21 – February 28

How do I qualify? Grants are awarded based on financial need to Catholic families.

Parish Employees Endowment Fund (Archdiocesan)

The Parish Employees Endowment Fund provides financial assistance for parish employees' children to attend an archdiocesan or parochial elementary school or an archdiocesan or parochial high school. Employees must work 1,000 hours or more over the course of the year. Grants are made on the basis of financial need as determined by the application process.

Where do I apply? The application can be found at www.ttef-stl.org.

When can I apply? January 21 – February 28

How do I qualify? Must be an employee of a parish. Scholarships are based on financial need.

MO Scholars

On July 1, 2022, the State of Missouri launched the Missouri Empowerment Scholarship Accounts Program known as MOScholars. It provides financial support to qualifying families to offset educational expenses including tuition.

When can I apply? February 1 – February 28

How do I qualify? Students must live in St. Louis City, St. Louis County, Jefferson County or St. Charles County and meet one of the following to qualify:

- Have a certified IEP or ISP
- 100% Free & Reduced Lunch Eligible AND attend a public or charter public school for one semester within the year prior to applying OR entering kindergarten or 1st grade

Assumption Partners in Education (P.I.E.) Grant

Assumption Partners in Education is funded by parishioner donations and is based on financial need.

Where do I apply? Application available in the Parish or School Office. Applications are due no later than June 30 to the Parish Office Attn: Deacon Sigillito.

How do I qualify? Scholarships are based on financial need. Families are required to apply for Archdiocesan scholarships through the Today and Tomorrow Educational Foundation at ttef-stl.org BEFORE applying for a P.I.E. Grant.
