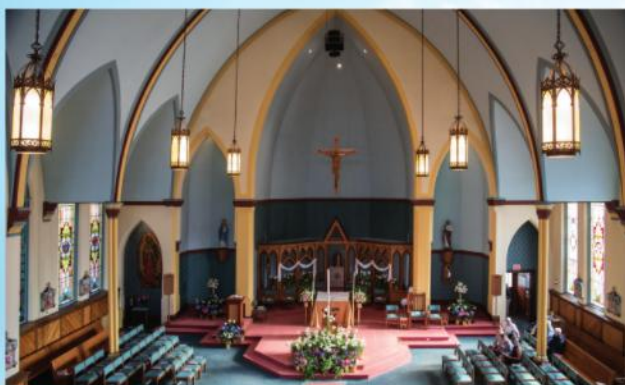
**THE SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM:** Baptism preparation class is required. Call the Parish Office for an appointment. No date can be set until after the appointment.

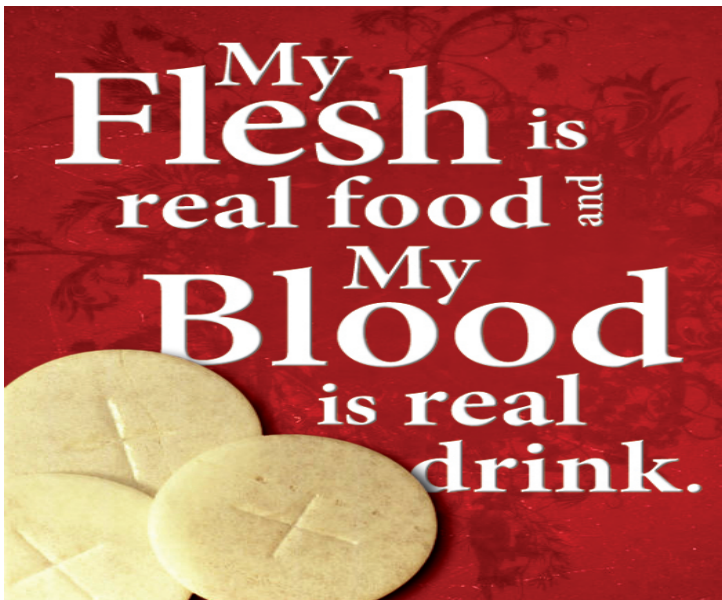

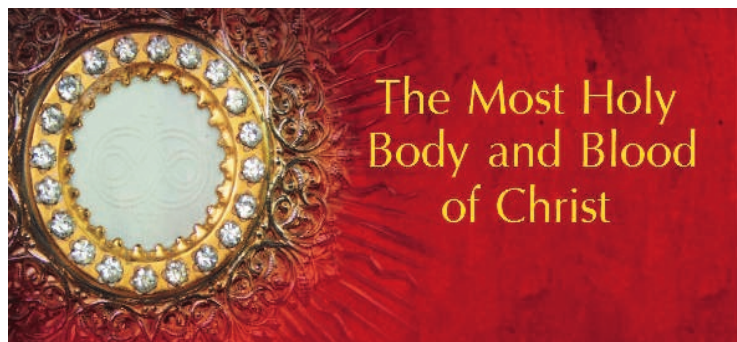
