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**The image** that today's Scriptures present us is the "banquet" that God prepares for those who are invited to the kingdom. In the first reading, this banquet is more than the physical satisfaction of sharing food and the company of guests. In Isaiah, the banquet is a symbol of the presence of God, who wipes away all tears and destroys death forever. The parable of today's Gospel sets the banquet in a different context. The king sends out the invitation for his son's wedding, but it is rejected by many who even kill the servants who bring it to them. This parallels the kingdom of God, to which all are invited but some reject the love of the son, Jesus. In this Sunday's liturgy, invite the assembly to reflect on the good and bad times of their lives with their family and friends. Did you recognize the presence of God in those times? How can we help others to seek comfort in God in times of crises?

La parábola del Evangelio de hoy sitúa el banquete en un contexto diferente. El rey envía la invitación para la boda de su hijo, pero es rechazada por muchos que incluso matan a los sirvientes que se la traen. Esto es paralelo al reino de Dios, al que todos están invitados, pero algunos rechazan el amor del hijo, Jesús. En la liturgia de este domingo, invite a la asamblea a reflexionar sobre los buenos y malos momentos de su vida con su familia y amigos. ¿Reconociste la presencia de Dios en aquellos tiempos? ¿Cómo podemos ayudar a los demás a buscar consuelo en Dios en tiempos de crisis?

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus speaks to us about our wedding garments. The man who came to the wedding without one was cast out. I don't think Jesus is referring to how we dress for mass, although some might argue that point. I believe Jesus is speaking directly about our moral actions. Are we or are we not living a life that corresponds to our baptismal promises. We were all given a baptismal garment at our baptism, which we are to keep spotless by the way we live our lives. The words for the Baptismal Rite speak very clearly of that, "you have become a new creation, and have clothed yourself in Christ. See in this white garment the outward sign of your Christian dignity. With your family and friends to help you by word and example, bring that dignity unstained into the everlasting life of heaven." Let us examine our lives and make sure we are living lives that correspond to our Christian dignity, so our wedding garments will be unstained when we enter the everlasting life of heaven.
