ENTRANCE	O Come, O Come Emmanuel BB 39		Lector will read an opening prayer and invite everyone to welcome those around them. Once the lector starts to walk to the back, the cantor should announce the entrance hymn.
PENETENTIAL RITE	Recited		Priest does penitential right: <i>Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy, Lord have mercy.</i>
GLORY TO GOD	No Gloria during Advent		Immediately following the Penitential Right.
RESPONSORIAL PSALM	Respond and Acclaim Page 12		Cantor will announce immediately following the 1 st reading
GOSPEL ACCLAMATION	Respond and Acclaim Page 13		Following the 2 nd reading - start the Gospel acclamation when the Priest stands and says – “let us rise for the gospel”.
PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS	All Creatures of Our God and King BB 568		Follows the prayers of the faithful read by the Lector with a short prayer by the priest.
HOLY, HOLY <i>Mass of Renewal</i>	BB 858		When Father says: “... <i>with the choirs of heaven, we cry out to your majesty on earth and without end we acclaim...</i> ” (or something similar)
MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION <i>Mass of Renewal</i>	We Proclaim Your Death BB 859		Father will genuflect after raising the cup and say: “ <i>The mystery of faith:</i> ”
AMEN <i>Mass of Renewal</i>	BB 862		Father will raise the cup and sing: “ <i>Through Him with Him, and in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever:</i> ”
LAMB OF GOD <i>Mass of Renewal</i>	BB 863		Immediately following the “Sign of Peace”
COMMUNION 1	Drawn to You BB 419		Start as soon as the cantor and accompanist are back from communion.
COMMUNION 2	A Voice Cries Out BB 46		Immediately following the 1 st communion hymn if needed. Plan to wrap up as Father sits following communion.
CLOSING	Sing a Joyful Song BB 571		Priest will give the final blessing. Cantor will announce the closing hymn.
