Who can be a Lector?

* Anyone with a strong and clear speaking voice that would like to share the readings with our parish community!

What does the Lector do?

* The two Lectors that are scheduled for Mass will share the readings of: The Welcome, the First Reading, the Second Reading, the Prayers of Petition, and any announcements.

How does a person prepare to be a Lector?

* After going through a short training, Lectors will be scheduled. Each Lector receives a Lector Workbook which has each weekends' readings in it. This allows you to read and practice the readings before your scheduled Mass. There are explanations of the readings, tips on how to emphasize the readings and pronunciation of certain words.

How often does a Lector read at Mass?

* Depending on which Mass you prefer (Saturday 5:15 p.m., Sunday 9 a.m. or 11 a.m.) and the number of active Lectors available you will be scheduled anywhere from once a month to approximately once every 2 to 3 months.
