Divine Mercy Sunday April 8, 2018

Divine Mercy Sunday will be celebrated here at St. Ann on Sunday, April 8th with a Holy Hour from 2:30– 3:30pm. Please join us to honor our Lord's request that the Sunday after Easter be the Feast of Mercy. He promised that the floodgates of heaven would open and extraordinary graces would be poured out among us. The Divine Mercy Novena began on Good Friday. We prayed the Novena in the wing of the church following the 3pm Liturgy of the Lords Passion. All are welcome to join us. In His revelations to St. Faustina, Jesus requested that a novena be said for the nine days preceding Divine Mercy Sunday. This novena includes a prayer for each day, and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. Jesus promised that He will bestow tremendous graces on all souls, and provide everything we need, if what we ask for is compatible with Gods will.
