**Please join us each week as we probe the depths of this Sacrament of Sacraments.**



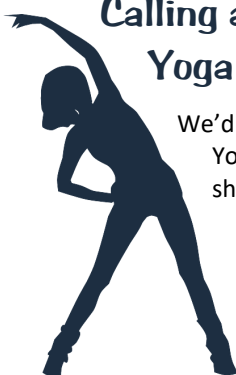

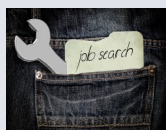
