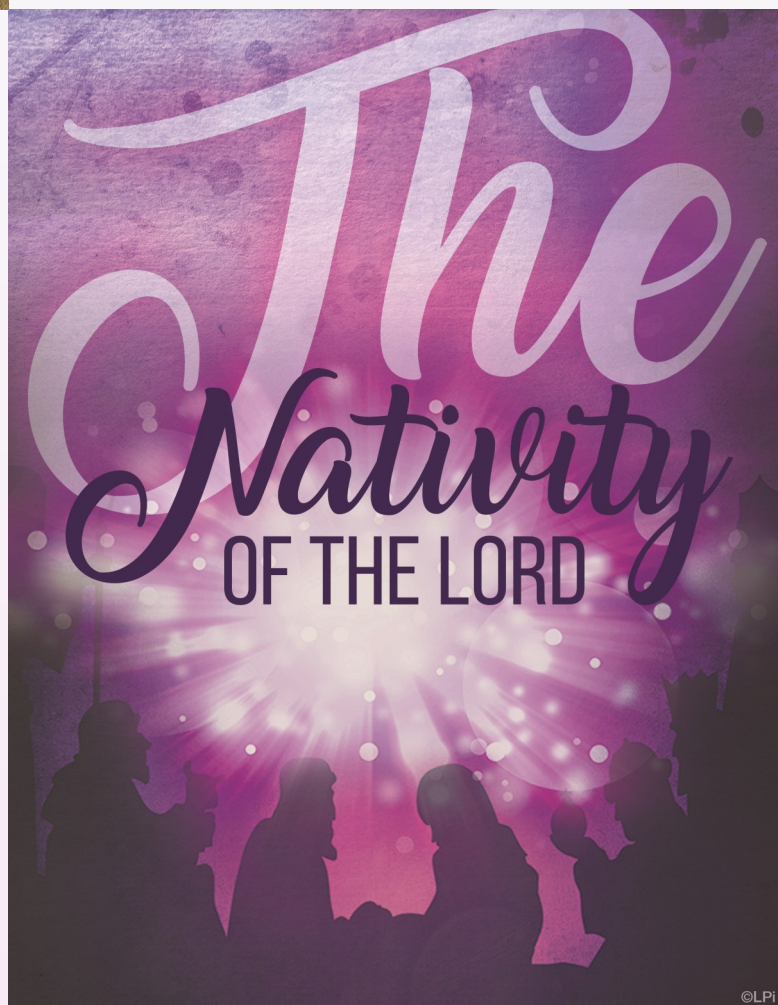

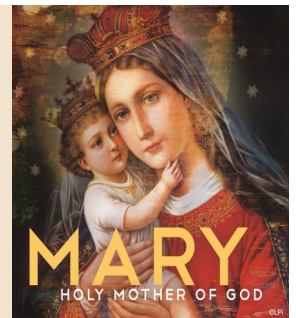
God,

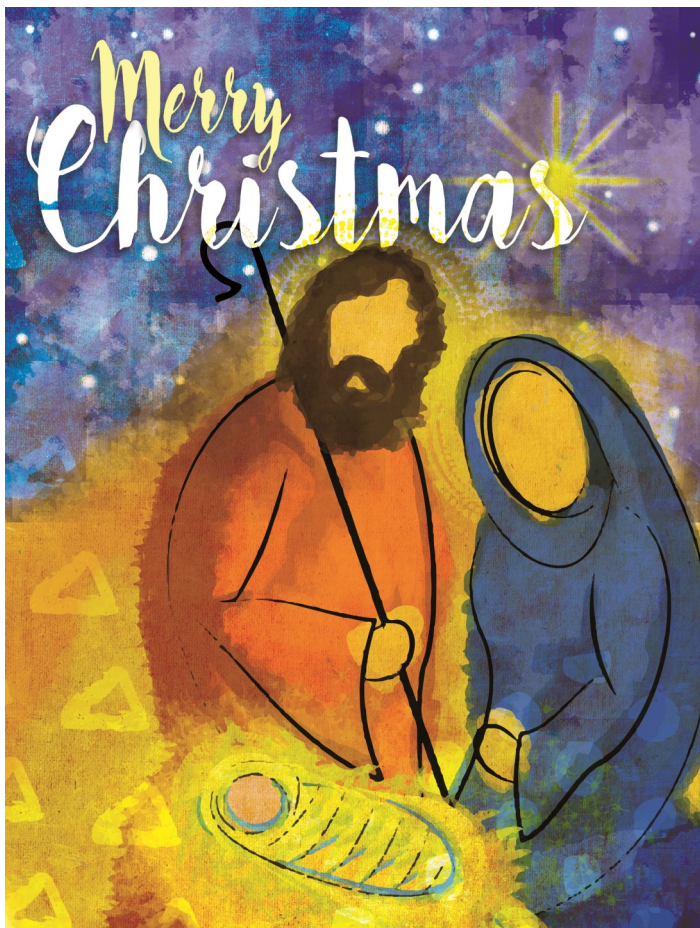

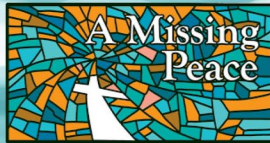
