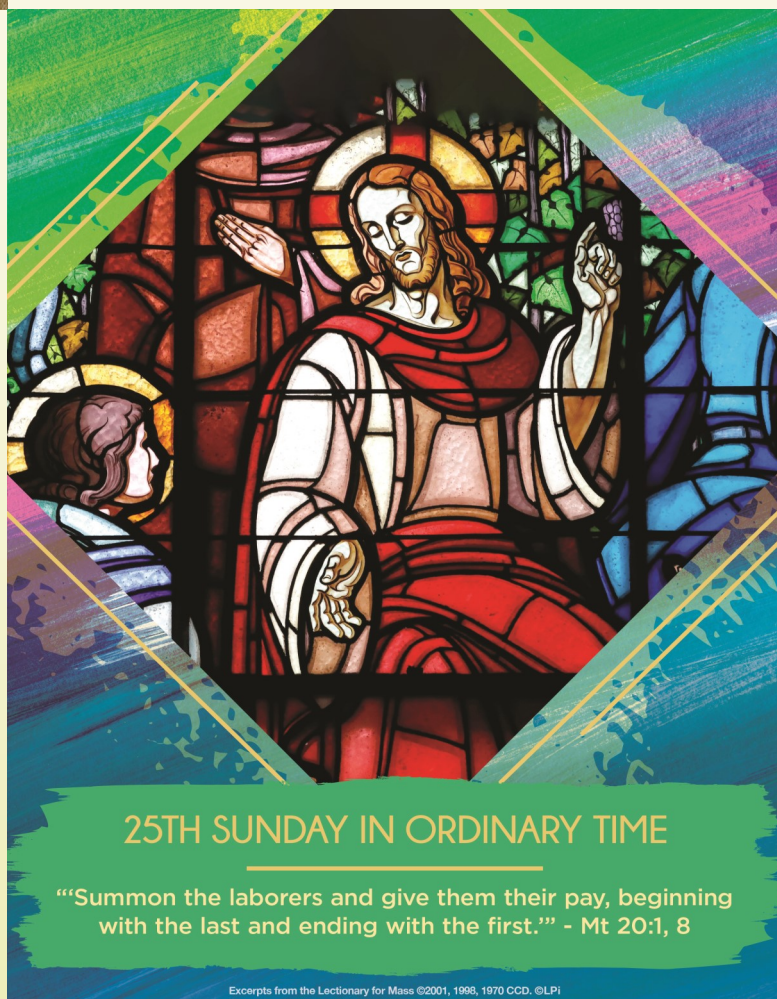

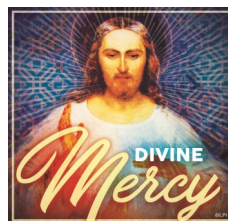

## PRO-LIFE MINISTRY

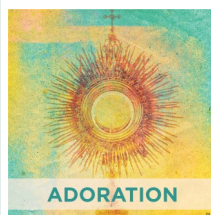
### 40 Days For Life Campaign

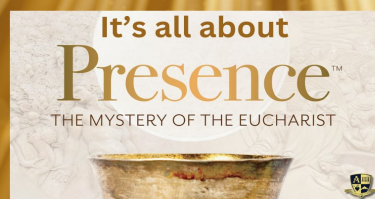

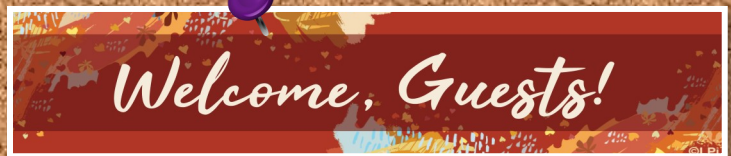
