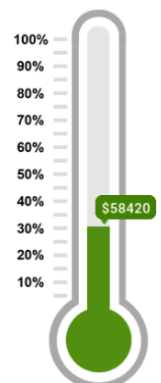

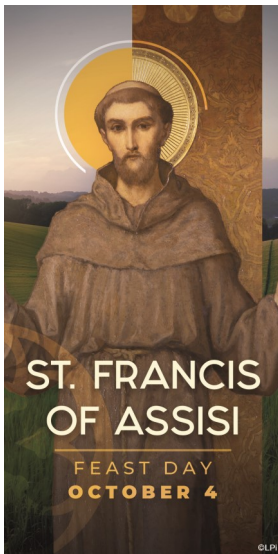

## PRO-LIFE MINISTRY

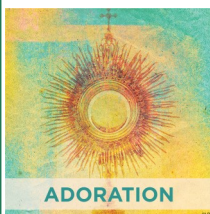
### 40 Days For Life Campaign

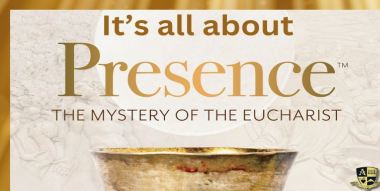

## The Holy Eucharist DID YOU KNOW?

We celebrate the Feast of the Guardian Angels this week on October 2<sup>nd</sup>.
