The Holy Eucharist DID YOU KNOW?

Today's Gospel is the parable of the wicked tenants whose forgetfulness foreshadows tragic consequences for them. (Matthew 21:33-43) We should ask ourselves if our own failure to remember the gifts, which await us at each Mass, also foreshadows sad consequences for us. St. Jean Vianney the Cure of Ars gives us some insights into the importance of the Holy Eucharist. He exhorts us to remember, "The Holy Eucharist is a greater gift than the Creation of the Universe."

Reflection: As we approach our reception of Holy Communion this week, never forget that as Catholic Christians we are sublimely privileged to receive the Living God under the appearance of a small, fragile, consecrated, white HOST. Jesus comes to us in His Divine Humility. How do we receive Him in return?


