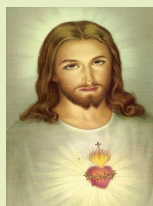

Thank you to everyone who contributed to the success of the Scholarship Committee's Clothing Sale!

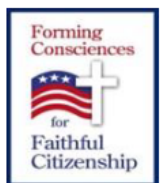
All told it took approximately 1100 hours to plan and implement this event, with over 88 volunteers sorting, organizing and displaying donations of 464 bags of gently used clothing donations. New this year we had handcrafted scarves made by St. Ann's Prayer Shawl Ministry.

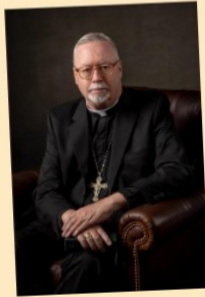

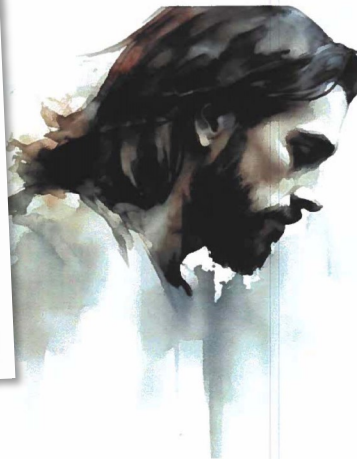
