

Weekday masses will take place in the Marian Chapel at St. James Parish on Thursday's and Friday's at 10 a.m. Everyone is welcome to join us for weekday masses. Weekend masses at St. James the Less are livestreamed to our St. James Facebook page for those unable to attend. The Parking Lot option of listening to mass on 88.1 FM in your vehicles is being maintained.

The Renfrew County Health Unit has informed our parishes: "RCDHU will allow singing with masks on, at a normal speaking volume, while the congregation is spaced 2 metres apart (not including households or caregivers). In this circumstance, we feel the risk of COVID transmission is greatly reduced. Please ensure that your congregation adheres to these restrictions for the time being until the provincial government makes further changes."



During the month of November, we honour our relatives and friends who have died. **You are invited to place flowers on the graves of those you wish to remember at St. James Cemetery, in Eganville.**

After Remembrance Day please remove all flowers from the cemetery including those on monuments. We will close the drive through gates with the first snowfall and any flower arrangements which remain at that time will be removed and disposed of. The walk-through gates will remain open for your use.

**Theme: Kingship of a Different Kind** – The Son of Man figure in Daniel, whose dominion is perpetual and whose leadership is indestructible, came to life anew in the New Testament presentation of Christ. The Johannine Jesus is questioned about his royal claims. While not denying his kingship, he indicates that it cannot be defined in Pilate's terms. In Revelation, Christ returns as sovereign at the end of history, a king who brings salvation to his people.


