Three Parish Partnership starts July  $\mathbf{1}^{st}$ . A letter from Fr. Vincent will be mailed out, it has been announced at masses. Fr. Raul will live at the St. Francis rectory; he will have a greater presence at the school. Fr. Michael continues his three rolls – vocations director, MCCM, Associate Priest for St. Joes. 
