

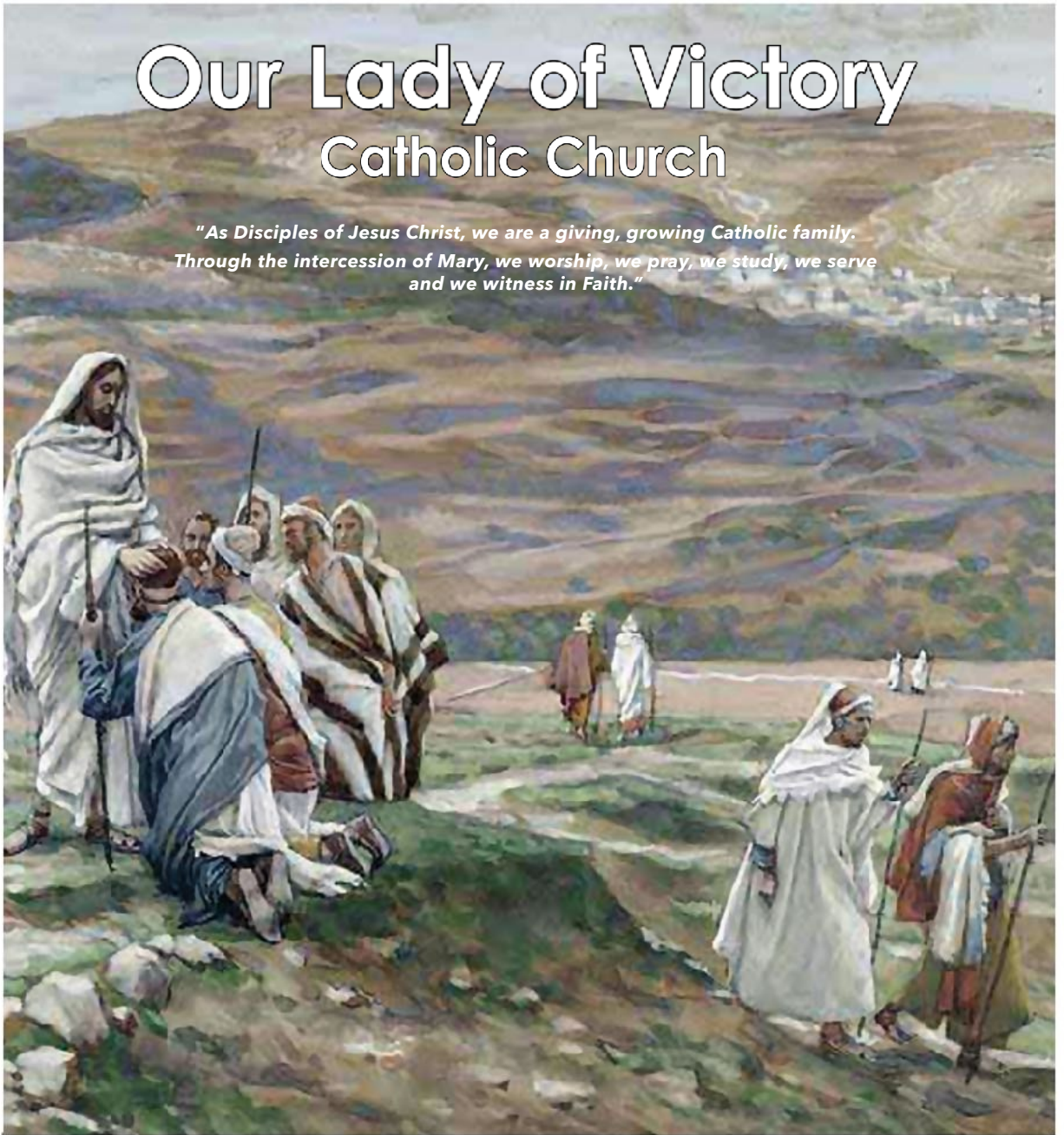

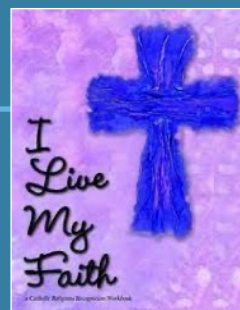

Dear Friends,

This weekend following the 11:30 a.m. Mass, a number of our Girls Scouts, will receive the **I live My Faith Medal**. I am privileged to confer this award upon them, after their successfully completing the program.

The **I Live My Faith** program is designed to help Girl Scouts and Camp Fire members, grades 4-6, appreciate more deeply the place that God and religion occupy in their daily lives. The program is structured on the Catechism of the Catholic Church with the themes of: **Belief, Sacraments, Catholic Christian Living, and Prayer**.

Each theme provides a variety of opportunities for young people to explore the Catholic faith including art, technology, research, drama, and prayer. Within each chapter, the girls are challenged to **Discover, Learn, and Connect Catholic Church teaching** to their lives while incorporating **Prayer** throughout the process. **I Live My Faith** complements and supports the more formal religious education provided in Catholic schools and parish programs.

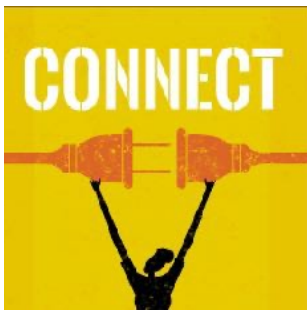
