Dear Friends,

The congregation of Our Lady of Victory Parish is celebrating the 100th anniversary of our church, in October of 2022! We invite you as parishioners and friends of the Parish to join us in the festivities that will be taking place over a number months, including the official Mass of Celebration on Saturday, October 8, 2022, at 5:00 p.m. The Mass will be followed by a lite outdoor reception.

In preparation for this big milestone, research and planning are underway for the creation of a Heritage Room that will be designed to tell the story of Our Lady of Victory Parish, from the early days when just a small group of faithful Catholics began the process of establishing a church in the Village North of Plymouth, to present the day, some 138 years later. As a Canonical Parish we celebrate 100 years, but as Catholics meeting in Northville since 1884... We've come a long way!

We are asking for contributions of photos, stories, and mementos. We are especially interested in older photos, dated circa 1920s, but we want to see anything that you have that is related to the parish or school or the surrounding properties that you might be willing to share. Please don't assume we already have something, or that what you have is nothing special.



Photos can be scanned and returned if you don't want to donate your originals. If you have a story to share you can either write it out for us and mail or drop it off to the Parish Office, olvoffice@olvnorthville.net, or we can do it interview style. Contact us through the office and we will arrange to accommodate whatever you have to share.

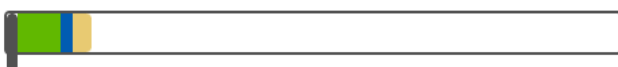

Today, we celebrate the Ascension of Jesus to his Father and home in heaven. The work he was sent to do in his short time on earth had been accomplished. Jesus left a seed of faith and a way of life

that the disciples continued in his name that has grown and remained for two thousand years. We are the products of that sown seed and as we blossom and grow, we also spread more seeds and so the legacy of Jesus continues.

We joyfully praise the ascended Christ with “A Hymn of Glory Let Us Sing,” written by the Venerable Bede, in the 7th century. Bede entered the monastery at the age of 7 and became a priest by the age of 30. He is known as a scholar, theologian, author of scientific works, poet, and musician. Because he wrote about the way Christianity moved through Britain at the time, he is called the “Father of English History.” The eight-stanza hymn was not translated until the 1850’s by Benjamin Webb. Only six verses remain. The hymn tune is LASST UNS ERFREUEN “let us rejoice most heartily” and first appeared in 1623 in a Jesuit hymnal with an Easter text.

A story about one of our catechism students....

Hi Ellen,

One of Sam's final 4th grade Catechism lessons was titled "The Church in the World". This lesson inspired Sam to think about what he could do to help the children effected by the war in the Ukraine. He came up with an idea to have a bake sale to raise money for a charity called UCARE, INC., (Ukrainian Children Aid and Relief Effort). Sam obtained approval by his teacher and principal to lead the initiative at his school. Fourth grade students made posters to advertise, labels for shopping bags with their logo - "**Cookies for Kids in the Ukraine**", and sold hundreds and hundreds of baked goods over a 2-day bake sale.

Sam's bake sale raised a total of **\$3,909.46** to help children in the Ukraine! I'm so proud of Sam and wanted to share this with you and Colleen.

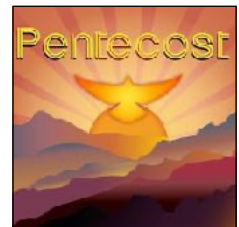
