

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Dear Friends,

The readings this Sunday all have something to offer concerning the meaning of Faith. Hebrews offers one of the most profound and beautiful descriptions of Faith found anywhere in the Bible: "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and the evidence of things not seen (Heb 11: 1-2)." Reality takes on a drastically new appearance when seen through the eyes of Faith.

The Gospel Parable told by Jesus, offers an insight into what it means to have Faith during those times in our lives when God seems absent. The foolish servant in the parable represents the person without Faith; once the master leaves it is as if he was never there and is never coming back. Therefore, anything goes, including the mistreatment of those under him in the pecking order. For the person without Faith, those times of unanswered prayer or terribly unfair treatment or prolonged suffering become the proof of God's absence in the world and in that person's life. Despair or cynicism lies at the end of that road.

For the person who has Faith, the reality looks entirely different. Like the servant in the parable who is ready to serve his master whenever he returns, because he knows he will return, the person of Faith when faced with the same trials may be confused about many things but is certain of one-God is present. Therefore, whatever may lie ahead, the person of Faith will not be traveling alone. The question changes, from "Where is God?" to "How is God making himself known to me in this particular time?" What a vastly different approach to dealing with difficult times comes from asking this question.



I always remember the story told to me many years ago, perhaps you have heard it as well; Two frogs are stuck in a bucket of milk, kicking their legs in a vain effort to leap out. The one frog despairs, falls back into the milk and drowns. The other frog keeps kicking, until the milk is churned into butter and he is able to hop out by leaping from the firmer surface.

CLIFE TEEN OLV Youth Ministry

The next international celebration of World Youth Day (WYD) is next summer, August 1-6, 2023 in Lisbon, Portugal. Since this trip requires a lot of preparation, <u>signing up for the trip is this summer</u>. The following describes WYD a bit. LISBON, AUGUST 1-6, 2023

WYD is a week-long international Catholic Youth event. It began by Pope St. John Paul II and held in 1986 in Rome. In 1993 it was in Denver. Currently, it is held every three years; typically, on a different continent. Registered attendance has been 300,000 to over 2 Million! The concluding Papal Sending Forth Mass often brings in additional crowds with a high of 5 Million in Manila (1995).

World Youth Day permeates an entire city and surrounding area. There is no place one can go throughout an entire metropolitan area without being within the WYD sphere of young people coming together in our Lord's name from almost every country in the world. Most people will never experience crowds such as these and it, truly, is a massive effort by Church, city and state all working together.

It begins with an opening Mass and an opening Papal appearance. It concludes with a Saturday Evening Vigil (led by the Pope) and Sunday Sending Forth Mass with the Pope. Each pilgrim (this is a pilgrimage, not a vacation) has an itinerary for the day which runs from early morning through the evening with catechesis happening each day throughout the city at multiple sites led by a bishop of your language. Sites may be in groups of a few hundred to a few thousand. Special events are occurring simultaneously each day, all day all throughout the city.

Pilgrims spend the day on Saturday hiking to a prescribed site where they "take up residence" (a sleeping bag in the outdoors in a very congested setting) awaiting a Saturday Evening Vigil Service and the next morning's Mass (which is a very long, yet dramatic and profound experience). There is no denying the exhaustion that can occur amid the energy of hundreds of thousands of young people coming together in one common faith endlessly singing, dancing, praying and praising in the name of our Lord, Jesus (and swapping souvenir pins, hats, shirts, flags & more).

We have been to many WYDs and the words "the Church Universal" takes on a whole new meaning for all participating. If you are interested, or have other questions contact Colleen Misiak or Deacon Ric. We can go over the details. You must be 16 years of age at the time of the trip.


