

Over the next few weeks, as we await the Liturgical Celebration of our Centennial, I thought that I would share with you, the history of OLV, our history, that we have been able to gather thus far. If you are aware of something that is missing, please don't hesitate in letting me know.

The story begins...

• May 25,1887: Fr. Brogger holds Mass for the Mission Church.

Father Broegger, of Wayne, will be here again next Wednesday to hold services in the Mission church. Services will begin at 10 o'clock in the forenoon.

 Anthony Kohler's family house was located at 212 S. Main (now the Wagon Wheel). Fr. Brogger lodged here when in town because it had easy access to the railroad. The Kohler Family was influential in arranging the first Masses for Northville residents.





- **September 21,1888**: The Ladies of the Society held a harvest supper fundraiser with proceeds going toward purchasing an organ for the church.
- March 8,1889: In honor of St. Patrick's Day, a resident made a donation for the benefit of the Catholic church at the residence of W. S. Wilkins.
- **July 5,1889**: It was noted that Fr. Brogger is succeeding well in building up his church society in Northville.
- **July 12,1889**: St. Mary Church of Northville, was a Mission Church that was originally under the care of St. Mary's Parish, of Wayne. For the following 33 years (1889-1922), St. Mary Church of Northville, was under the care of St. Mary's Parish, of Milford. The Catholic Parish numbering only 6-8 families purchased the *Old Methodist church* and moved it to North Center Street.

Concert Series! I am very pleased to announce a series of concerts, celebrating the 100th Anniversary of OLV Parish! The first concert will take place on Sunday, September 18, at 7:00 p.m., featuring Stacey Mason (Violinist & Vocalist) and Ken Krach (Pianist & Accompanist). Stacey Mason and Ken Krach have been performing together for over 25 years, providing music for church services, concerts, corporate events, and special occasions. They will perform a program of contemporary worship music featuring Stacey's vocal and violin virtuosity, as well as Ken's unique ability to artistically interpret and improvise over the written piano accompaniment. There is no admission charge. All are welcome!

Glory to God! Mass is a prayer of praise and worship. During the Mass, we pray (sing!), Glory to God in the Highest. We have just shown sorrow for our sins and asked for God's mercy as we prayed the Confiteor and Lord Have Mercy. Now, we give glory to God the Father, to His Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit. There are two ways the Glory to God prayer has been traditionally sung. One is the "refrain" style (The words "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace to people of good will" repeat throughout the prayer.) and the other is the "through-composed" style (The prayer is sung in its entirety with no repeat of text.) Prior to the release of the third edition of The Roman Missal several years ago, it seemed that more parishes chose to sing refrain settings of the Gloria than those that were through-composed. However, since the publication of the third edition of the Missal, an increasing number of parishes switched to singing a setting of the Gloria that was through-composed, as encouraged by the Bishops' Committee on Divine Worship.

The Glory to God we are currently singing is from the "Mass of Joy and Peace" written by Tony Alonso. He originally wrote it in 2010 in the refrain style. We currently sing this version. Ten years later Mr. Alonso wrote a through-composed version of the same composition. We will be singing this newer version beginning next week. It's a very subtle and simple change!






