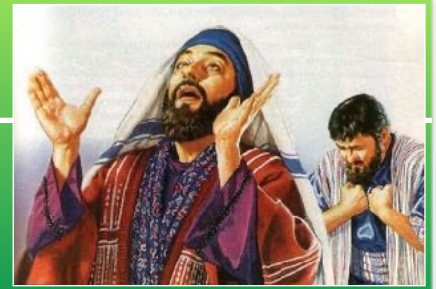

THIRTIETH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel passage, Luke writes that Jesus addressed this parable "to those who were convinced of their own righteousness" and who also despised everyone else. Jesus began the parable with the words: **"Two people went up to the temple area to pray; one was a Pharisee and the other was a tax collector."**

The Pharisee prayed, **"O God, thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity: greedy, dishonest or adulterous! I am grateful that I am not like the tax collector."** The Pharisee then said to God, **"I fast two times a week and I pay tithes on my income."** Clearly the Pharisee believed that he was superior to most people and was confident that God was very pleased with him, also.

The tax collector found a quiet place to pray. The man was so humble that he did not raise his eyes to heaven. Rather he beat his breast and prayed, saying: **"O God, be merciful to me, a sinner."** The tax collector was not demeaning himself but spoke the truth: **"I am a sinful man."** Jesus then said to his disciples, **"Those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted."**

In many arenas of today's world, humility is a quality that often is not appreciated. Every day we hear from the political candidates who are running for some political office and they tell us of their strengths and the vision that they have for our country, our State or even our cities. Some of the candidates are humble, yet other candidates believe they have all the answers for any question that might be asked. Humility is a quality that all leaders need to possess, at least to some degree. No one person has all of the answers or all of the wisdom. This is true also in families, churches, organizations, teams, corporations, and in any group of people who come together for a purpose.

Humility does not mean that we demean ourselves or pretend to be less than we are. True humility means that we recognize and acknowledge our limitations, as well as our gifts and our talents. No one person has all the answers. Humble people will freely ask for advice or wisdom and will acknowledge when they need help.

Jesus does not want us to demean ourselves, nor does he want us to exalt ourselves. Jesus has gifted each and every person with many gifts and talents; however, Jesus also realizes that we also have limitations and faults. Today, I invite you to be mindful of when it is time to share your gifts and talents, and when you could use some words of wisdom or insight from another person. Give thanks for the many gifts you have to share and give thanks for the many people who share their insights and talents with you. Together, we can enrich our world and our community and make it a loving and peaceful place!

Proposal 3 Thoughts... BY FR. DENIS



One of the more convincing people of the 20th century was Dorothy Day. As a child she had nominal faith but soon abandoned that and became an atheist, an anarchist and a communist. She had several affairs and twice tried to take her own life. She also had an abortion. But in December of 1927, Day was baptized and became one of the most consistent Catholic figures of the 20th century. A daily communicant, a woman of intense prayer before the Eucharist and a devotee of the rosary, Day was a champion for persons on the margins, much like a woman she met later in life was—Mother Teresa. Her cause for canonization is open currently and while it's not yet definitively concluded the fact that the Church is considering the canonization of a woman who had an abortion is a reason for extraordinary hope for all of us in general, and for many of us in particular.

Given the statistics on abortion, it is reasonable to presume that at every Mass, every Sunday, across the State, there is someone present, and perhaps, many present, who have, for whatever reason, either had or been involved in some way in an abortion. The God who is rich in mercy wants to speak in a special way to them...

There is nothing—**simply nothing**—that God won't forgive. The evil one has a relentless strategy with those who have experienced this trauma: God's mercy is not for you. But friends, this is a lie! For even St. Paul tells us in Romans, that "Christ died for the ungodly." Isn't that all of us; all of us in our brokenness?

The cross and resurrection of Jesus are not a reward for good behavior; Jesus did all He did because we are all desperately in need. (cf. Rom 5:6) The only thing that's different from person to person is what our sin is, but we're all in need. Unlike us, though, God loves to forgive, He loves to welcome home, He loves to give us second chances!

As a Church, we challenge you..."If you have not yet experienced His mercy in the sacrament of reconciliation, please come and celebrate the Sacrament. God allows us to begin again and again."

Some of you, may know someone, perhaps even someone close to you, who has suffered from a prior abortion. 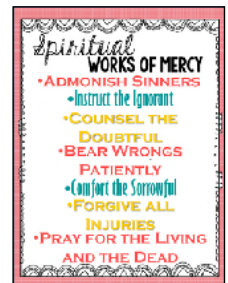
