

The Second Sunday in Ordinary Time



Dear friends,

Well, the Christmas Season has come and gone, and as “Church” we jump back into Ordinary Time until the beginning of the Lenten Season on February 22.

This Sunday’s Gospel, a familiar one to all of us, is the encounter between John the Baptist and Jesus. When John sees Jesus, he exclaims: **“Look! There is the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world. It is He of whom I said: ‘After me will come a man who ranks ahead of me because he was before me’.”** John then confesses that he had not recognized Jesus as the Lamb of God. Jesus and John had known one another from birth; remember they were cousins, or of some relation. Yet until this moment, John had not realized that Jesus was **“The Christ.”** John then gave this testimony: **“I saw the Spirit descend and rest on someone; it is He who will baptize with the Holy Spirit. I have seen for myself and I have testified, ‘This is God’s chosen One.’”**

I often ask myself... “Do you truly believe that Jesus is “The Lamb of God?” I suspect that many of you, like me, simply “grew up” with the Gospel and we were taught about Jesus and his life from our childhood. Yet today, I think that we are each confronted with the statement of John the Baptist... **“There is the Lamb of God!”** and we must ask ourselves: Do I truly believe that Jesus is **“The Lamb of God?”** Do we believe that Jesus truly is the Holy One of God? Most of us would say that we “know” about Jesus, however in our knowing, do we truly listen daily for His word and his presence in our life? Are Jesus and his teachings integral in our life? Or do we simply give “lip service” to our faith?

Today, I invite you to take time to search your heart and mind. You may be surprised at what you find there. I pray that you will find faith and peace within you!

PRAY THE ROSARY FOR THE SANCTITY OF LIFE...

We will pray together following the 9:30 a.m. Mass, on **Sunday, January 22.**

The rosary is a devotion strongly embraced by the pro-life movement. This is so, for good reasons, because in the Hail Mary we praise a mother, and we worship the fruit of her womb. Our salvation began because a mother said ‘yes’ to the life within her! In the rosary we also say, “Pray for us sinners.” We don’t point the finger at others, but rather, we pray for ourselves. We know that sin is in the world, but we start by repenting of the sin within us. That is the best way to rebuild the Culture of Life. To

help stop the anti-life push around the world, the late Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen encouraged the spiritual adoption of an unborn child. This is done by praying that the one particular but unknown child’s life be spared abortion and be allowed to continue to live. To help accomplish this, it was recommended an individual say the following daily prayer for a period of nine months.

“Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much. I beg you to spare the life of [baby’s name] the unborn baby that I have spiritually adopted who is in danger of abortion.” - Prayer of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen

Your prayers CAN make a difference between whether a baby will be born...or aborted. Our prayers can also be a form of spiritual support for both of the parents. Please share the love of life given to you by the Lord of all life and join in spiritually adopting a baby. Another Spiritual Adoption Prayer, by an unknown source offers this:

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you so. Please protect from abortion the unborn baby whom I have spiritually adopted. Save Lives. Save Lives. Save Lives. Amen.




