The Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time



Dear friends,

In today's Gospel, Jesus surprises the crowds with these words: "You have heard the commandment, 'An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth.'" However, what I say to you is: "Offer no resistance to any type of injury. If someone strikes you on the right cheek, turn and offer him/her your other cheek. Or if someone takes you to court over your shirt, give him your coat as well." Then Jesus gives other examples.

"You have heard the commandment: love your countryman and pray for your persecutors. This will prove that you are children of God. After all, the sun rises on the bad and the good and rains on the just and the unjust."

Jesus always hopes that we will act without limits on our love and our forgiveness. Often, this seems impossible to do; yet if we pray and strive to have an open heart, eventually we will be able to forgive the individual and hopefully develop a healthier relationship with him or her. How will we respond?

As we enter the Lenten Season, on Wednesday, February 22, our theme for this year is, **"HOPE in my HEART."** I pray that you will join along with me and our entire staff as we journey through Lent to Easter with HOPE in our HEARTS. On Christian hope, Pope Francis gives this advice on how to teach people, especially young people, to remain full of hope. No matter **"where God has planted you, hope. Always hope,"** he said, explaining:

- Enemy No. 1 is not out there somewhere, but inside oneself. **"Don't make room for bitter or dark thoughts."**
- **"Believe in the existence of the most noble and beautiful truths"** and trust that God, through the Holy Spirit, is ushering everything toward the good, toward **"Christ's embrace."**
- Believers are not alone in their faith. There are others who hope, too. **"The world goes on thanks to the vision of many people who created an opening, who built bridges, who dreamed and believed, even when they heard words of derision around them."**
- Never believe the struggles here on earth are "useless." **God never disappoints and he wants that seed he planted in everyone to bloom. "God made us to flower, too."**
- **"Wherever you are, build!"**

Think about joining us for one DAILY MASS a week during Lent this year. OLV celebrates the Eucharist on Monday, Wednesday and on Fridays at 8:30 a.m., and we celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Monday and Fridays mornings from 7:30–8:15 a.m. As we do throughout the year, Reconciliation is also offered every Saturday from 3:00-4:30 p.m. As a Family of Parishes, we will also celebrate Reconciliation with a Communal Service on Saturday, March 25, at 1:00 p.m. hosted by St. Edith Church and on Monday, March 27, at 7:00 p.m. hosted by St. Colette Church.

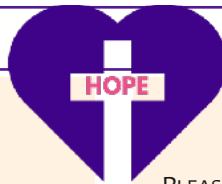

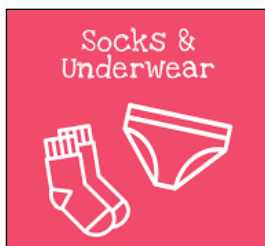
Live Your Faith. Join the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.

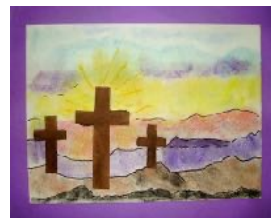
