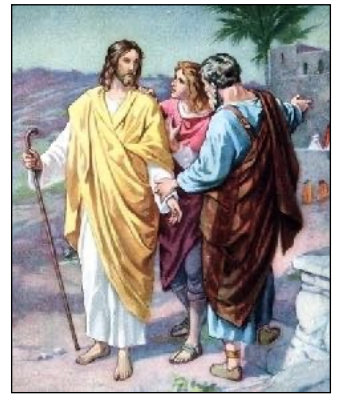
Third Sunday of Easter



Dear Friends,

The Gospel describes the journey of two disciples from Jerusalem to a village called Emmaus. One disciple is named Cleopas and the other is not named. There are some traditions that told Cleopas was the brother of St. Joseph. Other historical and scriptural writers consider him to be the husband of one of the Marys at the foot of the cross. Still others, speculate that the unnamed disciple is thus his wife, Mary. While the identity of the disciples is a bit shaky, it is worthwhile to reflect on this couple and what they were doing as they left Jerusalem: “talking with each other about all these things that had happened.”

“What is this conversation which you are holding with each other as you walk?” asks the Risen Jesus as he draws near. Responding to his “pretend unawareness,” they explain that they were discussing the events of Jesus’ passion, death, and the weird reports of the women who had visited the tomb. You can only imagine the type of conversation this husband and wife were having. This is an intimate conversation, not merely the discussion of discouraged brothers or disciples, but one that perhaps concerns their relationship. Husband and wife had both put their hopes and dreams in Jesus, which were dashed to the ground. This is indeed an exodus-walk to Emmaus, not one of mission, but a separation from hope and trust.



Yet, as Jesus draws near, he questions them, and explains the scriptures concerning himself. Ending with the breaking of the bread, Eucharist, their sudden recognition of Jesus, and his even more sudden disappearance, a remarkable change happens to the disciples. Their depression collapses to this exclamation: **“Did not our hearts burn within us while he talked to us on the road, while he opened to us the scriptures?”**

They then returned to Jerusalem, a seven mile walk, in the darkness, for it was “toward evening” and the day “far spent” when Jesus had dined with them. Yet this darkness was brighter than their walking in the day. Mirroring the exile and return of Israel to the Promised Land, Cleopas and his companion arrive in Jerusalem to hear the truth confirmed by the small community that is gathered, **“The Lord has risen indeed and has appeared to Simon.”**

I think a lesson about hopes and aspirations can be taken from this. When we mainly rely on our own judgements and efforts towards the way things ‘should go’, we inevitably become discouraged and ultimately depart from our hopes and dreams. We come to realize that we “can’t do it” on our own, so we compromise, give up, or maybe like the disciples just want to walk away. But it is precisely when we listen to God and his Word that our “hearts burn within us” and our anxieties are taken away.
