Rev. Denis B. Theroux, Pastor The Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel story, the eleven disciples receive what is known as the 'Great Commission'. Before ascending into heaven, Jesus gives the early Church community their marching orders: "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you."

The significance of this Great Commission cannot be over-emphasized. In his great encyclical on evangelization, **Pope Saint Paul VI** made the striking claim that the Church exists for only one purpose: **evangelization.** All of the Church's structures, communities, and sacraments are ordered to this one mission. The word evangelization derives from Latin's "good news". What is this good news? Of course, it is that Jesus has taken upon himself our sins, has buried them in death, and has gloriously resurrected.

The feast of the Ascension however, gives us another perspective on the Great Commission. While we tend to understand the Resurrection as good news, the Ascension can be misunderstood. Jesus ascending into the clouds might suggest that evangelization is all up to us. After all, Jesus left us immediately after the commission. Evangelization thus becomes a matter of human will-power. This reduces into an engagement: maximize all our efforts! It is up to us after all. Then, when our efforts meet resistance and inevitably fail, our ensuing bitterness then fosters...a why bother attitude. The Great Commission thus ends in a 'Great Dismissal': as a failure.




Jesus' first and last words in the Commission are terribly important to counter the idea that it is "all up to us". Jesus states: "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me... And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age"

The first part of the statement is curious. We know that Jesus is divine; as God, he already has authority over all things. We realize then that it's his *humanity* that is receiving authority. God has not just re-asserted his prominence, he has actually granted us a new Adam, a new human king, who *leads the charge*.

And the last part of the statement, "I am with you always" reminds us of the messianic title Emmanuel, meaning "God is with us". Rather than leaving the Church in the dust, Jesus leads the Church to the heavenly realm. Far from absent, Jesus continuously works with us, in us, and through us to make the good news a reality.

In truth, the great commission is about participation. This participation is neither just activity nor passivity, but is receptive and cooperative. Jesus' promise to be with us calms our anxieties but also gives us a challenge to change. The Great Commission is indeed a high demand, but Jesus provides the strength and the joy to carry it out.

HOLA from the Spanish class!

During the past few days, the students in OLV have been celebrating the Mexican culture in the Spanish class. The students in preschool and kindergarten learned about the way that kids in Mexico celebrate birthdays. While the rest of the students, from first to eighth grade, celebrated 5 de Mayo by learning about the "battle of Puebla" and Mexico's most important facts. Videos, stories, music, games, crafts, decorations, food, and even a field trip to a Mexican restaurant, were part of the celebrations.

The students in elementary enjoyed the songs and games. Like, the Bingo game containing food vocabulary and phrases related to the 5 de Mayo celebration. They also had fun with scavenger hunts, and expressed likes and dislikes with skits. Lower grades sang and danced around Mexican hats and completed booklets and picture dictionaries. The upper elementary grades used the menus that they created to role play dialogues about ordering food in a Mexican restaurant.

Middle school students did a great job using the vocabulary and grammar learned to write and act out dialogues. They ordered food and made comments about it through role-play. The eighth graders had the opportunity to order food in Spanish at the Mexican restaurant La Herradura, in Novi. There, we celebrated Cinco de Mayo and had a great time. They all were able to order food in Spanish and to understand when the waiters talked to them in the foreign language. I am very proud of them and wish them to continue to be successful at High School. They all certainly will be missed at OLV!

Haiti Outreach Mission (HOM)



For a number of years, OLV's Sewing Ministry created toys, blankets and clothing that HOM packed and took on Mission trips. The blankets were used for child examinations and went home with the patients. The toys were especially loved! In 2010, United Nations soldiers from Nepal caused an outbreak of cholera in Mirebalais which spread to the rest of Haiti. Good water

became very important. HOM has spent \$4,000 for a water purification facility in partnership with St. Louis church. The usual cost for purified water is 34 cents (50 Haitian Gourds) for 5 gallons. Fr. Romel charges 17 cents (25 Gourds). St. Louis church in Mirebalais pays most of the maintenance costs. For more information or to donate, please visit: *haitioutreachmission.org*.




