Dear Friends,

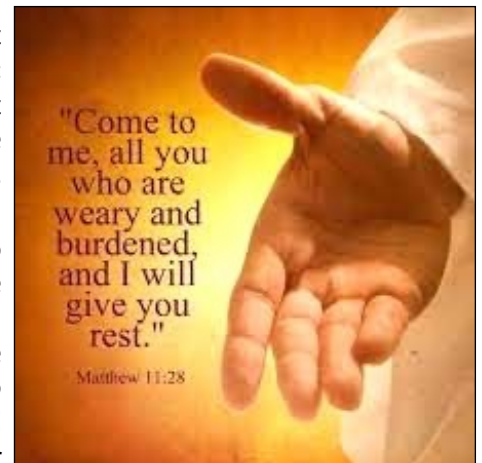
Today, we eavesdrop on Jesus as He speaks with His Father. Jesus is praising the goodness and graciousness of God for revealing to the childlike what is hidden to the learned. How would you describe people who are child-like (in the best sense of the word)?

In our world, we typically esteem individuals who are learned and wise, and rightly so. However, there are many different kinds of wisdom. There is the wisdom that comes from many years of study and learning. There also is street wisdom that we learn in our encounters with other human beings. And then there is the wisdom we learn by daily living the mystery of life. Frequently, I try to stop and ask myself: *Do I appreciate and give thanks for the wisdom I glean from my daily experience?*

Clearly, Jesus does not want us to be childish. Rather Jesus desires that we be **childlike**. When I think of the childlike I reflect on qualities like: guiltlessness, trust, or transparency. I try to remind myself that the greatest gift of childlikeness is the ability to see beauty and joy in the world. Or even the wonderful gift of an inner freedom to simply be who you are or to “be playful”, no matter what age you are.

Then, in this passage, Jesus invites all who are weary and burdened to come to Him. He promises us that if we come to Him, He will give us rest, and the rest He gives will renew and restore us.

How have to ask myself as I ask you to reflect, “What is it in your life wearies you? What wears you down or exhausts you? From what (and whom) do you need “rest?” It might be worry about your loved ones, health, or financial concerns. Perhaps it’s a feeling of being overwhelmed by your responsibilities or perhaps you feel alone.



I assume that you, like me, like most people, are weary to some degree. What do we do at these times? How do we cope with the weariness? Do we carry our burdens alone or do we share them with our family or friends? Do we take our burdens, anxiety, and weariness to Jesus and ask Him for the grace and rest that we need?

Wouldn’t it be wonderful if by simply taking our worries and weariness to Jesus that magically everything in our lives would become right again? We know however, from experience, that typically this does not happen. Even when we have taken our concerns or worries to Jesus, we may still may be worried and anxious. However, I do believe that if we bring our struggles to Jesus, He will grace us with the strength we need to continue.

Today, I challenge you to ask yourself: What concerns, worries or anxieties are on my mind and in my heart? Then I invite you to sit quietly with Jesus for a few minutes. Just simply be with Him. You don’t need to say anything since Jesus already knows what you are thinking and feeling. Place your anxieties, fears, or worries in His hands. If you quietly sit with Jesus, you may begin to feel peaceful and calm.

Somehow quietly being with Jesus may bring us a true sense of rest and it also may lighten our burden. Trust Jesus! He is waiting for you and for me!

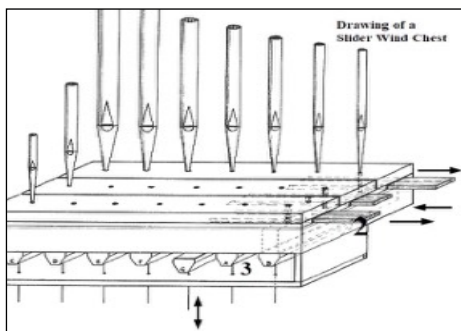
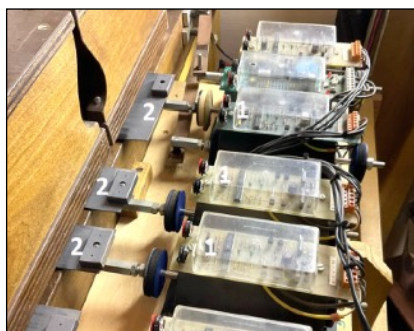
Children's Choir

The Children's Choir is for all children of the Parish in the second through eighth grade. The Children's Choir sings for school Mass each week and other scheduled weekend Masses throughout the school year. Children in the choir will be given the opportunity to learn how to cantor. ***Children that attend OLV School as well as those that attend other schools are welcome to join the Children's Choir. Children that attend OLV School will sing at all scheduled School Masses and select weekend Masses. Children that attend other schools will sing at select weekend Masses.***

Rehearsals take place on **Tuesdays, from 4:00 to 4:45 p.m.** throughout the school year. OLV School students will meet in the Fr. Ernie Center for a snack after school and then go up to church to begin rehearsal. Students from other schools will meet in church at 4:00 p.m. If your child has a passion for music and singing, please consider having them be a part of the Children's Choir! The Pipe Organ - Wind Chests

WIND CHESTS are wooden boxes upon which the pipes are set, containing valves and other devices that control the air flow into the pipes. The majority of the pipes of the OLV pipe organ sit on **electric slider** style wind chests (basic drawing shown below). A row of pipes is controlled by a **stop** on the organ console (a stop is a set of pipes such as a flute, trumpet, oboe, etc.). As the stop is activated the **slider motor (1)** pulls out a plastic slat called a **slider (2)**. The slider moves and holes in the slider line up with the pipes. Now those pipes can be played. When the organist depresses a key a signal is sent to the **pallet (3)** to open by means of a **magnet (4)**. The pallet opens and air enters a key channel. All of the pipes on that channel (whose stops have been turned on and opened) will sound. If you have any questions or would like a tour of the pipe organ chamber, please feel free to speak with me after any weekend Mass.

OLV TEENS – WE NEED YOUR HELP!



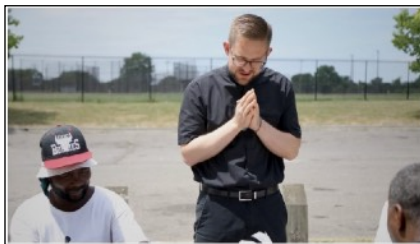

On December 3, 2012, our son, brother and friend David Widzinski died in his sleep. David appeared to be in perfect health and his passing was a tremendous shock to his family, friends and community. After David's passing, we decided to take action to remember David and the tremendous impact he had on many people.



Who was David?

- He was a fun loving, kind-hearted and compassionate 16-year-old Northville resident; a good student and athlete.
- He was friends with many OLV students and young people.
- Most importantly, he was a faithful, practicing Catholic young man who deeply loved and cared about people, and not just his friends or family,

but everyone, from the homeless, to the quiet or lonely, and to those who needed a friend. On the last day of his life (a Sunday), he texted a group of friends asking who wanted to go to Mass with him.

Since losing David, we hold a charity golf outing and dinner on the Sunday of Labor Day weekend. We call it the **David Widzinski Community Golf Classic** because it is a community event where we love, laugh, remember David, and help others.

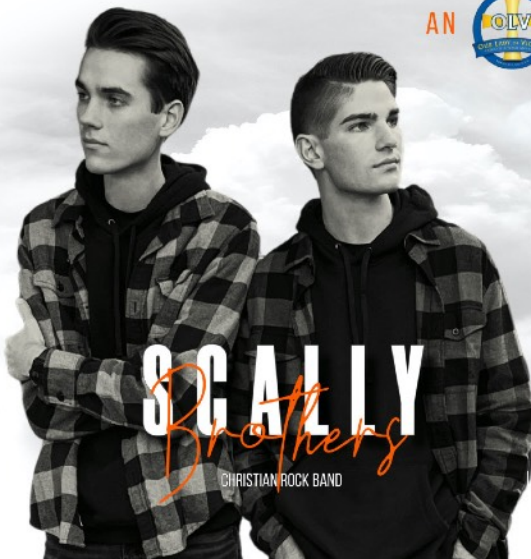
