
Dear Friends,

Some time ago, I remember reading a story in a magazine about a teenager who belongs to a local Swimming Team. Every morning she gets up at 5:30 a.m. to hurry to an outdoor pool for two solid hours of swimming, after which, she goes to school. After school, she returns to the pool to swim for two more hours. At 5:00 p.m., she hurries home to do homework. She goes to bed exhausted and waits for the alarm to ring at 5 a.m. to start it all over again. When asked why she follows such a disciplined schedule, she said, "My goal is to make the Olympic team." I will give up going to parties; I will give up staying up late, anything for a gold Olympic medal."

Had Jesus lived now rather than in A.D.30, today's gospel might have been very different. Rather than talk about a pearl merchant who sacrificed all to buy a dream pearl or a farmer who sold all to buy a field with treasure in it Jesus might have talked about a Swim Team swimmer—one who sacrificed all to make the Olympic team.

Why do I say this? What connection is there between a pearl merchant, a treasure seeker, and a swimmer? What do these three people have in common? The one thing they have in common is their total commitment to a dream. All three are willing to sacrifice everything for a goal they have set for themselves. And this is the point Jesus wishes to make for us in today's gospel. The point is this: Citizenship in God's kingdom involves total commitment on our part.


We can't pursue it as we do a part-time job. We can't work at it as we do a hobby. Being a Christian is like being a pearl merchant, being a Christian is like being a treasure seeker. Being a Christian is like being a swimmer on a swim team who



But, we do it for one that will last forever. That is the difference, the Pearl Merchant's prize. The farmer's treasure and the swimmer's medal are all perishable. At the moment of death, there is only one thing that counts.

It is not whether in life we acquired a prize pearl, a rare treasure, or a gold medal. The only thing that will matter is what we have become in the process of trying to seek the pearl, acquire the treasure or win the medal. What has the pursuit of these things done to us? How have they affected our daily life? Ultimately, whatever is yours is God's gift to you, even if it stems from your own fantastic talent, that talent itself owes its origin to God. But, a gift of God is not given to be clutched, it is given to be given.

Each of us, is a gifted person. Gifted in more ways, perhaps, than our discretion will admit. It matters not what our specific possessions are... millions or the widow's mite. Intelligence or power, beauty or wisdom, faith, hope, love,

gentleness, and compassion. What Jesus tells us time and time again is to use your gifts as He invites or commands you to use them.

Today's gospel makes an important point. Nothing in the world may take priority over God's kingdom and our pursuit of it. Today's gospel tells us that what counts when we die is not what we have acquired in life. But, what we have become.

#### SISTERS OF MARY IMMACULATE MISSION APPEAL


After all Masses: July 29-30



In the Gospel today (**Matthew 13: 44-52**), we find that the demand of daily Christian living is to spend our life primarily searching for the kingdom of God.

Reflecting on today's Gospel ... the person who finds the buried treasure in a field comes upon it by happenstance, the find happens without effort; it is a pure gift. The role of discipleship is to be aware of the treasure when it is found. Then the merchant ... who knows his/her business and recognizes the prized pearl when it is found. Here the role of discipleship is to be diligent in the search, not become discouraged and give up; seek until the "pearl of great price" is found. (Living Liturgy, p. 204)

#### The Pipe Organ - Swell Box

The upper keyboard on the OLV Pipe Organ plays the stops in the swell division. It is so called because the sound of its pipes can be made to swell and diminish. Its pipes are housed in a box (1) with shutters (2) on one or more sides. These shutters are like large venetian blinds that are controlled by the organist at the organ console using the swell pedal. When the shutters are opened, the sound gets louder and also more

brilliant. When the bund of the swell division

shutters are closed, the sound of the swell division pipes is muffled. The shutters are controlled by a mechanism called the swell motor (3). The swell division is located on the third level of the organ chamber (4) and is accessed by climbing two ladders, opening a small access door, and climbing in! It's not for those with a fear of heights! Next week's article will include a description of the pipes in the swell box. If you would like to tour the organ chamber, please see me after any weekend Mass.






