

Dear Friends,

The main character in today's Gospel is not Jesus. It is John the Baptist. In the Gospel, we hear John's testimony to the "light." In his preaching, John makes it clear that he is not the light. John's role is to prepare the people for Jesus' coming so that when he comes, they will recognize Him and believe in Him.

The people continued to barrage John with questions. They ask if he is Elijah or is he the Prophet that was to come? Finally, John quotes a passage from the prophet Isaiah: "I am the voice crying out in the desert." He simply says that he is the "herald," the one who is to foretell the coming of the Lord.

The Jews continued to bombard John with questions: asking why he was baptizing people if he was not the One who was to come? The Jews would not let him rest. They asked why he was baptizing and preaching if he was not the Christ or Elijah? Finally, John clearly and simply tells the people that his role is to prepare the way for Jesus. He tells them that he, John, is not worthy to even untie the sandal strap of the One who is to come.

The people asking the questions of John were hungry to know more about the "Messiah." They were hungry to have their questions answered. They wanted to have a sense of what would come. Of "Who" would come! They had been waiting for the Messiah for centuries! Perhaps they were beginning to wonder if the Savior would even come! They looked to Jesus to affirm their hope that the Savior would return.


What are the questions we have for Jesus? Are we hungry to know more about Jesus? Are we anxious for His coming? Do we recognize the ways He comes to us each day?



OLV SCHOOL NEWS

Words Matter in Middle School By Ms. Kristen Nash, Middle School ELA Teacher

Great learning is happening in 7th and 8th grade ELA classes this year! In Grammar and Writing, the 7th and 8th grade students are researching topics and connecting them to social justice principles. In addition to writing their research essays, the students are reviewing verbs – how to use active voice in their writing and how to use tense consistently. This week, they outlined their notes, and next week they begin writing their rough drafts. They impress me daily with the effort they give to master important skills, such as finding evidence to support their ideas and developing their writing voices.

After reading Charles Dickens' classic story, A Christmas Carol, the 7th graders attended a spirited performance of the story, presented at the Meadow Brook Theatre. Currently, the 7th graders are reading and discussing Lois Lowry's novel, The Giver. As for our 8th graders, they have been very busy: they recently finished reading Animal Farm, and they are now participating in a reader's theater version of Twelve Angry Men. After they finish reading the story, they will analyze the directorial choices used in the film version to see if the film remains faithful to or departs from the written text. All in all, the students continue to explore the meaning behind the words they read and write.

What Is the Difference Between Happiness and Joy?

On this 3rd Sunday of Advent, we light the **Joy** Candle. But sometimes Joy and Happiness get mixed up and it's good to know there is a difference.

"These things I have spoken to you, that my joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full." John 15:11

Joy. Jesus speaks about joy, and not just in passing circumstances. These words come at the Last Supper, when Jesus is giving some of his final words to his apostles before his passion. Obviously, what Jesus said was pretty important to him, "your joy may be full." What does that even mean? How are joy and happiness different?

In a way, we can make ourselves feel happy. Taking a nap will make us feel happy, but only for a bit. Finishing a big project usually makes us happy. We feel happy when our favorite team wins the big game. *Getting that certain gift at Christmas can make us happy.* We can, in a certain sense, make ourselves feel happy.

Joy, on the other hand, is entirely different. Joy doesn't come from us. Joy isn't a feeling. It's not a fleeting pleasure or jolt of high emotion the way happiness is. Joy is a fruit of the Holy Spirit and is planted deep within and maintained, by the Spirit. This Advent, stay open to the presence of the Holy Spirit in your life as we near Christmas Day.
