The Fourth Sunday of Advent



Dear Friends,

The Gospel reading for this last morning of Advent is the prophecy of Zechariah. It is the continuation of the story of John's birth. In today's reading, Zechariah is filled with the Holy Spirit. Later, John also prophesies that a Savior will come to his people. The Savior not only will come, but He also will save them and set them free.

When Mary heard that Elizabeth was pregnant, she immediately hurried to be with Elizabeth. Just imagine the conversation these two women had! Both of them became pregnant in highly unusual circumstances. Yet both women were filled with complete faith and trust in God—and faith in the miracle they each were gifted with.

Joseph and Zechariah also had to be men of deep faith and trust in their God. Did they wonder what else their lives would hold? Yet they trusted the God they knew and loved! What faith these women and men had in their God!

These kinds of happenings are unusual in our day. Often if I hear of a miracle, I question it. I wonder if a true miracle really did happen since miracles seem to be in short supply today. Yet we have miracles around us all day long—if we have the faith and the eyes to see them and recognize God's action.

On this Christmas Eve may we open our minds, eyes and hearts and look deeply for God's action in our lives and in the lives of the people we love! God is with us! God is acting! The question is: will we see and believe?

Merry Christmas from the OLV Music Ministry!

We are currently accepting new members to join the OLV Music Ministry! The Music Ministry at OLV enhances our liturgies and celebrations with the Church's rich tradition of music, both vocally and instrumentally. Participants enjoy that special sense of community that comes from making something beautiful together for God and for his people. At OLV, we have many opportunities for you to participate in our liturgies through music. Please contact me anytime if you're interested or would like more information.

CHILDREN'S CHOIR: The Children's Choir is for all children of the Parish in the second through eighth grade. Children that attend OLV School, as well as those that attend other schools, are welcome to join the Children's Choir. Children that attend OLV School will sing at all scheduled School Masses and select weekend Masses. Children that attend other schools will sing at select weekend Masses. **Rehearsals resume on Tuesday, January 9, 2024, 4-4:45 p.m.**

ADULT CHOIR: The Adult Choir is for people in the community who have a passion for singing. The Choir maintains an exciting and active rehearsal and performance schedule. The choir typically sings at the 9:30 a.m. Mass on Sundays. In addition to this the choir will sing for *Holy Thursday*, *Good Friday*, the *Easter Vigil* and for an *Easter Concert* in April accompanied by a Brass Quartet. Singers must be in the 9th grade or older and the only requirement is the ability to be able to "carry a tune". **Rehearsals resume on Thursday, January 11, 2024, 7-8:30 p.m.**

HANDBELL ENSEMBLE - Anyone in the ninth grade or older is welcome to join. An audition is not required. Some musical knowledge is helpful but not necessary. Ringing technique is taught, along with note recognition, rhythm, and timing. Currently, our Handbell Ensemble is full, although substitute ringers are needed from time to time.

CONTEMPORARY MUSIC GROUP: This spirited ensemble of musicians performs contemporary Christian music that is different from our traditional choirs. They can be heard each week at the Sunday Mass at 11:30 a.m. **Rehearsals take place on Wednesday evenings at 7:00 p.m.** For more information, please contact the Director of Contemporary Music, **Tim Johnson**.

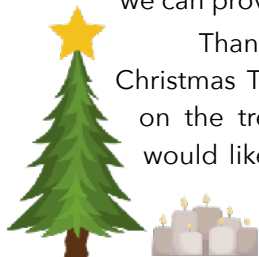
RESURRECTION CHOIR: The Resurrection Choir is made up of volunteers that enjoy singing and are available to sing for funeral Masses. There are no rehearsals. The Resurrection Choir welcomes anyone who wishes to participate. You do not need to have previous experience singing in a choir.

CANTORS: There is a special role for soloists with the ability to inspire singing from a worshipping assembly. The liturgical soloist acts as cantor of the Psalm and Gospel verse, as well as the leader of songs and acclamations in the absence of a choir. The main requirement for this role is preparation, so the desire to study the text and read the music is very helpful. Other important skills are the ability to sing clearly, in tune, and with confidence. This is a specialized ministry requiring an audition and training sessions with the Music Director.

As we listen to today's Gospel (**Luke 1:26-38**) imagine how Mary felt at the birth of Jesus: excited, awed, frightened. Deep faith was her light in the darkness, for Jesus was born during the night of the year when darkness is the longest.

Now imagine how Joseph felt as the birth of his mysterious son approached: puzzled, excited, awed. Deep faith was his light in the darkness, it allowed him to see the presence of God where suffering, privation and violence appeared to reign. Joseph knew poverty when there was no room in the inn, he witnessed violence when Herod unleashed his wrath against the children in Bethlehem, he felt persecution when he fled to Egypt. Yet he believed ... he believed God walked with him, was faithful to His promises, was alive. Joseph lived on the edge of mystery yet was not afraid to gaze into it with courage in order to find God. 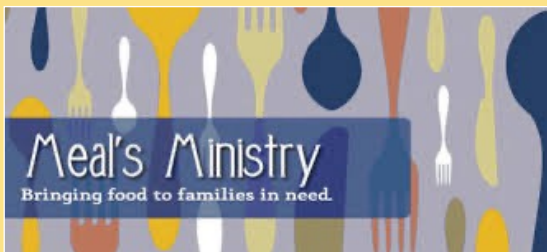

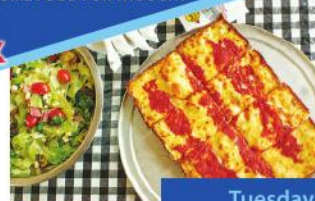
