Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

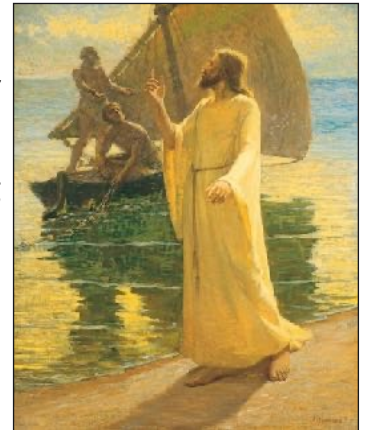


Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel begins in the middle of Chapter One of Mark's Gospel. This section of the chapter immediately follows the account of John the Baptist's arrest. Despite the fact that John had been arrested, Jesus continued to Galilee to proclaim His message. Everywhere He went, He proclaimed that the time of fulfillment, the kingdom of heaven was at hand. Jesus preached a message of repentance. He invited people to believe in the Gospel.

I wonder what the people who heard him preach thought of Jesus and His message. Andrew and Simon were among the crowd who listened to Jesus' message. Jesus singled them out and invited them to follow Him. Immediately they dropped their nets, and left their families to follow Him. Jesus must have been a powerful speaker. Also, His message must have been very different from what the other prophets preached. There was something about Jesus that deeply touched Simon and Andrew. Jesus had something they longed for. Thus, they left their nets and boat to follow this man, Jesus.

As they walked along, Jesus called Simon and Andrew. Then going a little further, Jesus also called James and John to follow Him. What was it about Jesus that inspired these common, down-to-earth men, to leave their livelihood, their families and their home to follow this itinerant preacher? Jesus must have had a powerful presence but also a message that spoke to their hearts!



Why do we follow Jesus? Do we do it because it is what we learned as children? Do we follow Jesus because that is what we are supposed to do? Is Jesus a real person to us or is He simply a character in a story to us? Today take some time and reflect on this question: **who is Jesus to you?** **Does Jesus make a difference in your life?** I pray your answer is **YES!**

OLV Concert Series

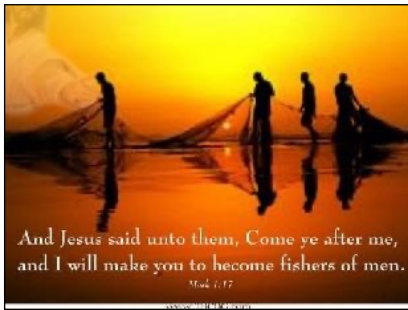
The OLV Concert Series continues on **Sunday, February 25, at 7:00 p.m.** with a program titled "Music for the Lenten Season" featuring Christa Grix, Harp and Cristina Muresan, Violin.

Equally adept as both a classical and jazz harpist, **Christa Grix** is one of those rare individuals who can make the transition from the jazz rhythm section to the symphonic string section sound effortless. The appeal and respect her music generates has taken her throughout the U.S., Canada and Europe as an invited soloist and clinician at major harp festivals and conferences.

Christa enjoys using the sound of the harp and the sound of her voice to create meaningful, beautiful communication and connection with her audiences. In addition to her 4 recordings on the Freefall Music label: *Freefall* (1996), *Cheek to Chic* (2002), *Moonlight on Snow* (2012) and *Christa's Presents* (2014), she is an on-air development host for WRCJ-FM in Detroit, where she researches, writes, and produces short educational spots that highlight the numerous connections between classical and jazz music.

Cristina Muresan is currently a member of Chicago's Grant Park Symphony since 2001 and a guest violinist for the Detroit Symphony since 2004. Violinist Cristina Muresan started playing the violin at the age of 7. At age 19 she was appointed violinist with the Romanian National Opera Orchestra in Cluj-Napoca, her hometown. She holds a Bachelor in violin performance from "G. Dima" Music Academy Cluj-Napoca and a Master in Music Performance from Bowling Green State University, OH. She was awarded a full fellowship to study with the late Isaac Stern. Cristina served as concertmaster for the New World Symphony, Miami Beach FL under Michael Tilson Thomas and participated in the European tour and several recordings. For 10 years she was first violin member of the Toledo Symphony where she was featured as a soloist. Cristina participated in festivals like Spoleto Italy, Music Academy of the West, Aix-en-Provence, France. Cristina plays a violin by French luthier Paul Bailly dated 1890. She resides in Northville with her husband and two boys.
