Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion



Dear Friends,

Today, we hear Mark's account of Jesus' passion and death. On Good Friday, the Gospel we will hear is from John's Gospel. The story is, of course, basically the same but each of the authors has a unique perspective of this horrific day. The Passion of Jesus is for me, like for most of you, etched in our hearts and minds!

Most of us will never have to experience what Jesus did. However, we each have had our own version of passion and death experiences. Our death experiences were not what our ultimate death experience will be. However, throughout our lives, there are times when we "die" a bit, and perhaps more than a bit. Perhaps you or a loved one is struggling with illness, divorce, loss of a job, financial problems or the death of a loved one. Or it might be a serious conflict in your family or in the workplace. If you are experiencing emotional pain, most likely loss is an integral part of your pain.

Take a moment or two this week and reflect on your life. Remember a time when you experienced a passion or a death? What was that like for you? When you reflect on that time do you re-experience the pain and loss again? What were the emotions that bombarded you? Who supported you? How long did it take for you to recover from that experience? Do you still experience the pain when you remember that time?

Hopefully, much of the pain and emotion of that time has subsided. With time, often there actually may be gifts that you have received from that horrendous experience. Ask yourself: what were the gifts or insights that you received from that time? Perhaps it was something you learned about yourself. Or it may have strengthened your bonds with your family, a friend or even a co-worker. We probably learn more from the painful and challenging situations in life than we do from the good events or situations. However, it can be an excruciating way of learning!

This week we walk with Jesus through the last days of his life. Jesus freely and lovingly gave his life for us. There truly is no greater love! As we journey through this Holy Week, may we ponder the many gifts that Jesus has given us and that He continues to bless us with. What do we give back to Jesus, not because we owe Him but rather we give out of love for Jesus? There has never been a greater love!

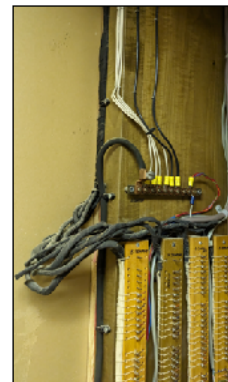


OLV Concert Series

Our next concert, "A Celebration of Easter", will take place on **Sunday, April 21, at 7:00 p.m.** featuring the OLV Parish Choir, Brassworks Brass Quartet/Timpani, and Mary Zelinski, guest organist. We will take a journey, musically, through the Easter season showcasing music composed for choir, brass, and organ. The concert will also be interactive, giving those in the congregation an opportunity to sing! The choir has been hard at work on this music since January. The OLV Pipe Organ

There are seven areas of concern regarding the pipe organ that were discovered upon a detailed inspection of the instrument. The final topic is a minor one! Some of the electrical wiring is cloth insulated. This is no longer standard practice in pipe organ building, and although it poses no risk as it is low voltage, it should eventually be replaced.



Summary

Over the past several weeks I've shared with you all of the issues with our instrument. The bottom line is that our instrument is not in the best **mechanical** condition. The greatest thing of value in our instrument is the pipework. Overall, the pipes are of quality construction and tone, and mostly in very good condition. So, it can be said that it is in good **tonal** condition. The instrument sounds great and I do my best at Mass to showcase exactly what it is capable of. Recently, I shared all of these findings, in detail, with an Organ Committee made up of staff members and parishioners in an effort to come up with a plan to address all of these concerns. I hope to share this information with you after Easter. Until then, please reach out to me anytime if you have any questions or comments.

She talked about the Summer Picnic that we put on for the children of St. Dominic's and that each child gets to pick 5 books and 2-3 toys each year. Some people of the Parish donate bicycles and they raffle those off. She encouraged the girls to join them this coming summer as it is a perfect opportunity for them to give service. She also talked to them about the fall backpack supply, Trick or Treating at Halloween and a Christmas party all for St. Dominic's Parish.

She went through the Corporal Works of Mercy and how the "Pack the Truck" for St. Vincent DePaul provides clothes, how they help those in need pay the rent if they are in a bind, how they provided water to the city of Flint when they had a problem, how parishioners take communion to the sick at Providence hospital, and they send paperback books to the prison. The girls learned about Social Justice and how they are not too young to start charitable giving as part of their Christian living. OLV is fortunate to have someone like Nancy, who is the perfect model of what all of us Catholics should be doing with our spare time.
