

Solemnity of Saint Peter and Saint Paul



Dear Friends,

This weekend (June 29), the Universal Church commemorates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul, two pillars of the early Church whose lives and ministries continue to inspire and guide believers worldwide. This day holds profound significance as we honor their courage, faithfulness and unwavering commitment to Jesus, which laid the foundation for the spread of the Gospel and the growth of the Church.

Saints Peter and Paul, though distinctive in their backgrounds and initial missions, share a common bond in their dedication to Jesus and their essential roles in the early Christian community:

This Solemnity celebrates the unity amidst diversity within the universal Church. Peter, as the first leader, (Pope) and Paul, as the Apostle to the Gentiles, exemplify how diverse backgrounds and missions can converge in service to Jesus. Despite their differences, both saints embraced their unique roles in spreading the Gospel and nurturing the early Christian communities. Their unity in faith and mission is a powerful reminder of the Church's continuous call to universality and unity under the authority of the successor of Saint Peter, the Pope. This unity transcends cultural, ethnic and geographical boundaries, reflecting the Church's mission to proclaim the Gospel to all nations and peoples.

The martyrdom of Saints Peter and Paul in Rome underscores their steadfast commitment to Jesus and His Church. According to tradition, both saints were martyred during the persecution under Emperor Nero: Tradition tells us that Saint Peter was crucified upside down, considering himself unworthy to die in the same manner as Jesus, while Saint Paul was beheaded as a Roman citizen.



Their martyrdoms symbolize the ultimate sacrifice for their faith and devotion to spreading the Gospel message. Their enduring legacy continues to inspire Christians to live boldly for Jesus, even in the face of persecution and adversity.

The Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul invites us to reflect on the enduring legacy of these apostles and their contributions to the growth and unity of the Church. Their lives inspire us to embrace our own vocations with courage, fidelity and a deep commitment to proclaiming the Gospel message to the world.

May we, like Saints Peter and Paul, be steadfast in our faith, united in our mission, and unwavering in our love for Christ and all of us, His Church. Through their intercession, may we grow in holiness and bear witness to the very power of the Gospel in our lives and in our communities.



### Right to Life – LIFESPAN God Bless America this Fourth of July

June 24 marked the third anniversary of the *Dobbo* decision overturning the Federal mandate of *Roe*. Using census data, the Journal of the American Medical Association (which is not pro-life) estimates

22,180 babies were allowed to be born in the United States since June 2022 due to States which protect the right to life either in full or beyond 6 weeks gestation in a study published February 13. Certainly, for U.S. Catholics, but also for all U.S. Christians, and all Americans, it is an honor to have a native son in Robert Prevost as Pope Leo XIV. Pope Leo used his first address to Vatican diplomats to state, "No one is exempted from striving to ensure respect for the dignity of every person, especially the most frail and vulnerable, from the unborn to the elderly..." All men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are Life, Liberty, and the pursuit of Happiness.


