Today we have the familiar story of Martha and Mary. As we know, Martha was a "workaholic" and Mary was a "contemplative." When Jesus arrived in the town where Mary and Martha lived, He immediately went to their home. Martha welcomed him and then she immediately went to the kitchen to prepare a delicious meal for him.

Mary, however, sat down at Jesus' feet. She talked with him and listened attentively to him. As time went on Martha began to get angry with Mary because she was in the kitchen doing all the work and Mary was not helping at all! In Martha's mind, the very least Mary could do was ask her if she needed help with the meal preparation. However, Mary did not do so.

While Martha was cooking, her anger escalated until she was extremely upset and angry. Here she was slaving away at the stove while Mary sat at Jesus' feet talking with Him. Finally Martha had had it; she decided to express her frustration and anger. She went to Jesus and said: "Lord, do you not care that Mary has left me to do all the work? Tell her to help me!" However, Jesus did not respond to Martha as she hoped. Rather Jesus scolded Martha for being so anxious and worried. Then He told Martha: "There is need of only one thing. Mary has chosen the better part and it will not be taken from her."



Put yourself in Martha's shoes. How do you think you would respond to this reprimand? Would you react as Martha did or would you pause and reflect on Jesus' statement and your reaction to his words? Would you be rational enough to ask yourself: "Am I jealous of Mary's relationship with Jesus? Or are my priorities out of order?"

Today, Jesus asks each of us: What takes priority in your life? One way to answer this question is to ask ourselves: How do I use my time? Do I squander it away? Do I work 12 hours a day? Am I involved in activities I enjoy? Do I spend quality time with the people I care about? Do I make time for prayer and spend time with God?

No one else needs to know the answers to these questions. However, our answers to these questions may give us some insight into our lives. In our busy and distracting world, it is easy to get off-track. Today, Jesus is inviting us to come away and spend time with Him. What a wonderful invitation! Will we accept His invitation or will we ignore it because we are too busy?


We have kicked off our annual Catholic Services Appeal. The theme of the 2025 Catholic Services Appeal is **Do you. Love me? Feed my sheep.**

### Celebrating 30 Years of Music Ministry July 1, 1995–July 1, 2025

I recently celebrated a personal meaningful milestone—30 years as a church musician.

My journey began in the summer of 1995. It was a requirement for all incoming church music/pipe organ majors at Wayne State University to obtain employment as a church organist. I began working at **St. Mark Catholic Parish** in Warren, Michigan on July 1, 1995. For three years, I played for daily and weekend Masses, weddings, funerals, and accompanied the choir. It was here that I spent countless hours—often up to five a day—practicing and honing the craft of organ playing.





In 1998, I transitioned to **St. Joseph Catholic Parish** near Eastern Market in Detroit. There, I played for all weekend liturgies, celebrated in English, Latin, and German. The grandeur of that historic church was a formative and humbling experience.

Later that year, I explored music ministry in a different tradition, accepting the role of Director of Music & Organist at **Southfield Presbyterian Church**. This was my first opportunity to lead a choir and

oversee a music program—a valuable and enriching chapter, even if not a long-term one. But my path soon brought me full circle . . .





I grew up in Detroit's Warrendale neighborhood and attended school at SS. Peter & Paul (SSPP) beginning in Kindergarten. I still remember the first time I heard the pipe organ there—I was five years old and knew, with certainty, that I wanted to become a church musician. In February of 1999, I returned to SSPP—this time as Director of Music and Organist. Professionally and personally, it was a profound homecoming.

Shortly after assuming the role, I met Gabriela. We married at SSPP in August of 2003, and soon after, she joined me as Associate Director of Music, bringing her deep knowledge of Polish liturgical music.

Together, we served the parish for over two decades—thousands of Masses, devotions, concerts, weddings, and funerals.

Though I once thought I'd remain at SSPP until retirement, change came in 2022. I began discerning a new chapter, and in a moment of reflection told Gabriela in late January of 2022, "If the position at OLV ever opens up, I'll apply." Just weeks later, and to my surprise, I received an email about the very opportunity I had spoken of. I applied—and on July 1, 2022, exactly 27 years after my music ministry began, I joined Our Lady of Victory Catholic Parish (OLV) in Northville as Director of Music Ministry.

Three years later, I'm grateful beyond words. It is an absolute joy to serve under the leadership of **Father Denis**, whose inspiration and support have made these years some of the most rewarding in my career. I'm equally thankful for the talented and kind colleagues I now work alongside as well as all those who volunteer in music ministry as they are the true backbone of everything that happens musically at OLV.



As I reflect on these past 30 years, I do so with a heart full of gratitude—for the pastors who guided me, the musicians I've collaborated with, the parishioners who inspired me, and the friends and family who supported me throughout. To do what I love for this long has been the blessing of a lifetime. I look forward with hope and excitement for all that lies ahead.

Would you like to be a part of this story? Members of the Music Ministry share in the joy of creating something beautiful together-offering their time and talent to God, and enriching the spiritual life of our parish. Whether you're a seasoned musician or someone who simply loves to sing or play an instrument, you'll find a warm, welcoming environment where you can grow, contribute, and connect. Let's continue to lift our voices and instruments in joyful praise—for God and for His people. Let's make beautiful music together.

On December 3, 2012, our son, brother and friend David Widzinski died in his sleep. David appeared to be in perfect health and his passing was a tremendous shock to his family, friends and community. - He was a fun loving, kind-hearted and compassionate 16-yearold Northville resident; a good student and athlete.

- Most importantly, he was a faithful, practicing Catholic young man who deeply loved and cared about people, and not just his friends or family, but everyone, from the homeless, to the quiet or lonely, and to those who needed a friend. On the last day of his life (a Sunday), he texted a group of friends asking who wanted to go to Mass with him.

Since losing David, we hold a charity golf outing and dinner on the Sunday of Labor Day weekend. We call it the David Widzinski Community Golf Classic because it is a community event where we love, laugh, remember David, and help others.
