# AROUND THE TABLE

*Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time*

Dear Friends,

In today's Gospel passage, Jesus emphasizes the importance of time and priorities to the disciples. Some of His statements might have been confusing for the disciples, who were unaware of the events that would later evolve in Jerusalem. However, Jesus' message about being prepared and prioritizing was clear.

Time is a precious gift, and each of us has it in an unknown measure. Procrastination acts like a thief, diminishing this gift by leading us to do nothing or to choose the easy tasks over the important ones. Without clear priorities, it is challenging to use time wisely. The more demands we face, the more crucial it becomes to determine what truly matters. Jesus clearly states that the most important priority is to being ready for the day that we meet Him in our death. The awareness that we will die one day, without knowing when, serves as a powerful organizing principle. Although it is difficult to contemplate, procrastination is not an option for disciples.



Procrastination often evokes thoughts of idleness, but it can be disguised by constant activity. Being perpetually busy does not mean we are focusing on what truly matters. If we let activity overshadow the more challenging spiritual tasks, we are procrastinating on our priorities.

When life feels chaotic due to numerous demands, the lack of time to think and reflect can lead us to prioritize tasks that can be completed quickly or those accompanied by the loudest voices. These may not be the true priorities. Long-term goals, deeper needs, and tasks with the potential for beneficial change often get neglected, both in our personal lives and in our work or family lives.

Taking a moment each day to consider what matters most on a personal level and in relation to the demands we face is a powerful tool for readiness. It can bring order to chaos and reduce procrastination on important matters. It can also provide a calm and assertive approach to overwhelming demands. Most importantly, it brings the question of readiness, as Jesus asked, back to the forefront.

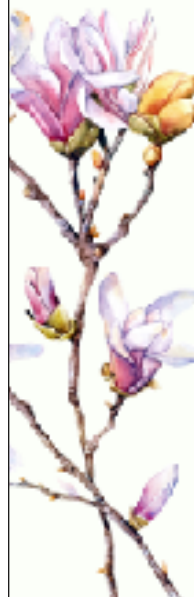

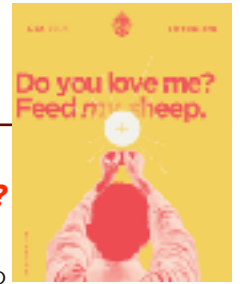

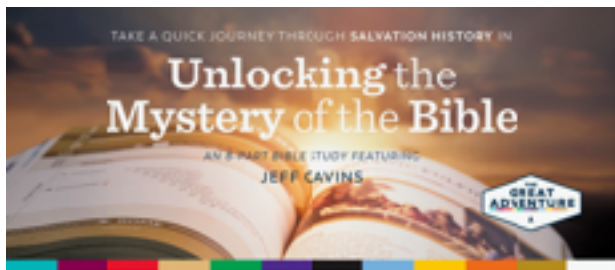
### Handbell Ensemble

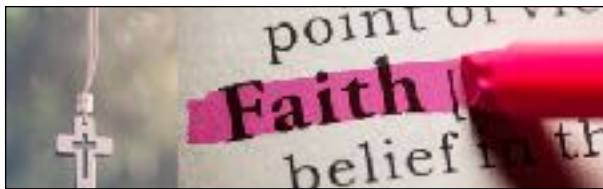

## **Rosary at the Grotto on Thursday, August 14, at 7:00 p.m.**

St. Maximilian Kolbe was a Polish Conventual Franciscan friar and became known as the Apostle of Consecration to Mary as a result of his tireless devotion to Our Blessed Mother. He was ordained as a priest in 1918. St. Maximilian would go on to organize the Militia Immaculata (Army of the Immaculate One), create a major religious publishing center at Niepokalanow, Poland, found monasteries in Japan and India and provide shelter for refugees at his monastery during World War II -including 2,000 Jews escaping German persecution. In 1941, his monastery in Niepokalanow was shut down, St. Maximilian was arrested by the German Gestapo and he was ultimately sent to Auschwitz where he was martyred on August 14. His remains were cremated on August 15, the Feast of The Assumption of Mary. He was canonized in 1982 by another native of Poland-Pope St. John Paul II who is also well-known as having a life-long devotion to Mary.

Please join the Knights of Columbus for our next Rosary recitation on Thursday, August 14, at 7:00 p.m., at the Grotto. August 14 is also the Feast Day of St. Maximilian Kolbe. He and Our Blessed Mother will be most pleased to hear our prayers that evening. As always, everyone is welcomed!
