Twenty-Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Friends,

Do you always express gratitude to the Lord for the countless blessings He bestows upon you? After healing the ten lepers, only one returned—a Samaritan, someone not of Jesus' faith. This is why Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine?" Indeed, what happened to the other nine who were members of Jesus' faith?

Jesus was looking for them, perhaps because they shared His faith. He expected them to return and show their gratitude. However, the nine were missing; they were good only at seeking favors from Jesus. Once they received what they wanted, they were nowhere to be found.



This behavior is common among many of us. We pray earnestly when we need something from the Lord, but after receiving it, we sometimes forget or neglect Jesus. It's not just with Jesus that we fail to acknowledge favors; we often forget to recognize the goodness of our family members, friends, and even strangers who have done us good. Such behavior is forgetful or even ungrateful. Yet, we must always be thankful for all the blessings we receive from the Lord.

Join me in reflecting on Jesus and let's ask ourselves if we have thanked Him for the many blessings He has given us. For instance, do you thank

the Lord for the gift of life every morning? Is expressing gratitude to the Lord our first priority each day?

In everything, let us be grateful to Jesus for our life, health, and all our blessings. We thank the Lord not because He needs it, but because we deeply value His goodness towards us.

Winter is fast approaching! Now is the time of year to do some fall sorting and cleaning. Why not Pack the Truck for those in need with all your items? The SVdP truck will be located in the **church** parking lot.

- We <u>will</u> accept: clean, gently used clothing, blankets, towels, sheets, shoes, boots and coats, as well as small kitchen items such as pots, pans, silverware, dishware sets and small toys. Old extension cords, phone cords, appliance cords cut from the appliance, lamp cords or Christmas light sets are also acceptable but placed in a box or bag that is **labeled** cords so we can separate them from the clothes. Shoes and boots must also be separated and labeled as well.
- We can not accept: furniture, pillows, car seats or small appliances.

All items donated will be delivered to one or more of the **SVdP Thrift Stores in the metro Detroit area** (Madison Heights, Waterford, Utica and Detroit). If you have furniture that you wish to donate, please call (313) 393-3025 to schedule a pickup.

Please place all clothing items in **kitchen size garbage bags**. This makes it easier for us to handle. Thank you for helping us help others!

All Donated Items Should Be Given to the Volunteers during the drop-off times. Only old cords can be dropped off in the designated bin in the Church Atrium!




HELP needed at OLV School
