# AROUND THE TABLE

*The Third Sunday of Advent*

Dear Friends,

Today's Gospel has a double focus. The first part of this Gospel concerns John the Baptist. The second portion of the Gospel focuses on Jesus. John was in prison and when he heard about the works that Jesus was performing, he sent some of his disciples to Jesus. He told his disciples to go to Jesus and ask: **"Are you 'He who is to come' or should we look for another?"**

When John's disciples approached Jesus and asked him the question John had posed, Jesus replied: **"Go back and report to John what you hear and see. The blind see, the lame walk, lepers are healed, the dead are raised to life, and the poor have the good news preached to them. Blest are the ones who find no stumbling block in me."** In a very clear way, Jesus told John's disciples that He was "The One" sent from God! I wonder how the disciples reacted to Jesus' words. Did they immediately believe Him or did they not know how to respond to his statement? After they heard Jesus' statement, John's disciples immediately left and reported to John what Jesus had said.



Then Jesus began to speak to the crowds about John the Baptist. He asked the people: **"What did you go out to see—a reed swaying in the wind? Or someone dressed in luxurious robes who lives in palaces? Or did you go out to see a prophet?"** Jesus said: **"A prophet indeed...and something more!"** Jesus then quotes a passage from Scripture: **"I send my messenger ahead of you to prepare your way."**

Now take a moment and ask yourself: Why do I turn to Jesus? Why do I seek Him out? Do I go to Him because I believe in Jesus? Do I only seek Him out when I am struggling or desperate? Do I regularly spend time with Jesus? The gift is that Jesus is always there for us, waiting for us to come to Him. I often take this for granted until life gets difficult. However, Jesus is not only our Savior; He is our friend and our guide. Today make time to spend with Jesus. Jesus is always with us; however, often we are the ones "not present" to him. If we open our hearts to Him, Jesus will be there with us and He will grace and guide us. May we trust Him always!





February 15-21, 2026




My name is **Brother Thomas Skowron**. I'm a Capuchin Franciscan friar and a priest living at the St. Bonaventure Monastery in Detroit.

As we prepare to celebrate one of the most wonderful times of the year, many of us may find our minds and hearts thinking of those loved ones we have lost. As a way of keeping their memory close during the holiday season, we invite you to add a memorial ornament to our *Tree of Remembrance* in the church Gathering Space. ## Oplatki Christmas Tradition

The tradition of the Oplatki originated in Poland during Early Christian times. This Christmas Custom began with a simple white wafer, baked from flour and water. The wafers are wonderfully designed to display Christmas images, such as the Nativity. Families enjoy the Oplatki, typically right before the Christmas Eve meal. The entire family will gather around the table with the Oplatek. Generally, the eldest member of the family will begin the ritual by breaking off a piece of the wafer and passing it to another family member with a blessing. This blessing can simply consist of what you desire for your loved one in the upcoming year—whether it be good health, success, or happiness. The purpose of this act is primarily to express one's unconditional love and forgiveness for each member of his or her family.

The significance of the Oplatki Christmas wafer is that it shadows the Eucharistic meal that Catholics participate in at each Mass. Just as we share in the Eucharist as one family in Christ and receive Christ's love through the Eucharist, the Oplatki allows for one's immediate family to come together and share the love they have for one another.

The Oplatki tradition is one that is easy and fun to introduce to the family at Christmas time. All it requires is a simple wafer paired with love and affection, and the willingness to share it. This is a heartwarming tradition that will complete your family's time together during the Christmas season.

We have a number of packages of the Oplatki available in the Gathering Space. They are available first come, first served. Any donation you wish to offer will help to defray the cost.

## READINGS OF THE WEEK | THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT
