The Epiphany of the Lord

Dear Friends,

A story is told about a man who was thinking of something that he can give Jesus this year? Then, he immediately answered his question by saying; *“I will be prayerful and I will teach others how to pray.”*

The Magi from the East presented extraordinary gifts to the baby Jesus—Gold, Frankincense, and Myrrh. **Gold** symbolized Jesus' kingship, **Frankincense** signified that the child Jesus was to be worshipped, and **Myrrh**, traditionally used for anointing the dead, foreshadowed His eventual death on the cross.

What is the best gift you could give Jesus this year? Is it your time and strength for the furtherance of the gospel, or is it your treasure and knowledge? Whatever it may be, give Jesus nothing less than your very best. Do not mind what it will cost you; you have to give Jesus what He truly deserves, for He is your Lord and Savior.

Sometimes it is very hard to give especially if we will not immediately receive something in return. Many of us find it difficult to give to Jesus because He does not physically reciprocate our generosity.

But, where can we find Jesus in this era of social media such as Facebook, Instagram, X and so forth? Can we find Jesus in these social media platforms? No, we cannot find Jesus there.

Jesus is in the poor that we pass by every day, in the hungry and homeless we always see, and in anyone who desperately needs yours or my help. Have you ever felt the desire to give them something, but you held back?

This year, maybe don't hold back when you see or pass by them again. Give them something, no matter how small or insignificant it may seem to you. For that something means the world to them. And it means the most, I believe, to Jesus!

Epiphany is the day, when we typically mark our door post and lintel with the new year's inscription using blessed chalk. The tradition of writing the year and the letters "**C+M+B**," representing the three wise men, **Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar, invokes the Magi and asks God's Blessings in the New Year.** The inscription: first the two digits of the year, followed by the initials ends with the date of the New Year. So this year, the inscription should be: **20 + C + M + B + 26.**


Join the OLV Adult Choir and Enrich Your Musical Journey!

3. If you are donating two or more Sunday envelopes at one time, only one check is needed for the total Sunday donation.
4. Special Collection envelopes should have separate checks for each collection.
5. As always, please be sure to include the date, written amount, and signature on each check.
6. If you would like to switch your donation to the online format, please call the Parish Office and we can help you get setup!


Do you Love me? Feed my sheep.



Our Lady of Victory Parish is setup for online giving, a web-based electronic contribution service. We provide this service so that you have the option to manage your contributions to the church from the comfort of your home PC or smartphone. At any time you can change your offerings, update your giving options and keep your account information accurate. This service is safe, secure and convenient for you. The vendor that we are partnered with to provide this service is the same as the one that provides us our offertory envelopes, **Our Sunday Visitor** (OSV). The options to donate are the same as an envelope—weekly offertory and special gifts for holy days and charities but also allows one time donations and monthly or quarterly withdrawals, too. Plus you also have the option to use your credit card!

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

This link is also available at <https://olvnorthville.org/donate>, click the Online Giving tab. Create an account. Log in and choose the option to **Give a New Gift**.

Using the online service to donate to the church and other charities replaces the mailing of the offertory envelopes to you every two months. This saves Our Lady of Victory money and helps save the earth’s resources. Thank you for your support.
